Dear Director Bayo;

Please be advised that MSM Utilities is amending its application for amendment of Certificates 611-W and 527-S to extend water and wastewater services in Charlotte County. The amendment will remove certain areas that were included in the original submission. We will submit an amended application for the commission's consideration.

In the meantime, please find the enclosed communication notifying all property owners who received the Legal Notice of October 18, 2005 and referenced in Exhibit N of our application, of our intention to amend the application. The net effect of the amendment is to remove the areas where property owners have objected to being included in the service territory and retain those areas of future development where the property owners have expressed an interest in having water and wastewater services available. The eight property owners along Hunter Creek Drive who remain in the area to be added (as of this writing none of these residents filed objections with the Public Service Commission), will receive the letter and will personally be contacted by me to discuss the amendment.

NOTICE TO AMEND APPLICATION
SERVICE TERRITORY EXPANSION
