

The following are the symbols used for the purposes indicated below:

- D Delete Or Discontinue
- I Change Resulting In An Increase to A Customer's Bill
- M Moved From Another Price List Location
- N New
- **R** Change Resulting In A Reduction To A Customer's Bill
- T Change in Text Or Regulation But No Change In Rate Or Charge
- **A. Check Sheets** When a price list filing is made with the FPSC, an updated check sheet accompanies the price list filing.
- **B.** Sheet Numbering and Revision levels Sheet numbers appear in the upper right corner of the page. Sheets are numbered sequentially. However, new sheets are occasionally added to the price list. When a new sheet is added between sheets already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new sheet added between existing sheets 14 and 15 would be 14.1. Revision levels also appear in the upper right corner of each page. These levels are used to determine the most current sheet version on file with the FPSC. For example, the 4th revised sheet 14 cancels the 3rd revised sheet 14.

SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

Samples of terms

Access Line - An arrangement which connects the customer's location to the Company's network switching center.

Authorization Code - A numerical code, one or more of which are available to a customer to enable him/her to access the carrier, and which are used by the carrier both to prevent unauthorized access to its facilities an to identify the customer for billing purposes.

Company or Carrier - DTI Telecom

Central Office - A location where there is an assembly of equipment that establishes the connections between subscriber access lines, trunks, switched access circuits, private line facilities, and special access facilities with the rest of the telephone network.

Customer - The person, firm, corporation or other entity which orders service and is responsible for payment of charges due and compliance with the Company's tariff regulations.

Exchange - The entire telephone plant and facilities used in providing telephone service to subscribers located in an exchange area.

Intra-LATA Toll Messages - Those toll messages which originate and terminate within the same LATA.

Message - a completed telephone call.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

A company providing basic local service <u>must</u> include billing and payment arrangements and the levels of service quality which the companies holds itself out to provide for each service.

Companies must also state that access to 911 will be maintained during temporary disconnections for non-payment of a residential subscriber's local service.

SECTION 3 - BASIC SERVICE DESCRIPTION AND RATES

3.1 Service Description

If basic service is offered, the company must state that it offers access to 911, operator services, and relay services and a flat rate for unlimited local calling.

DTI Long Distance Service

DTI Long Distance Service is offered to residential and business customers. The service permits direct dialed outbound calling at a single per minute rate. Service is provided from presubscribed, dedicated or shared use access lines. Calls are billed in one minute increments. No monthly recurring charges or minimum monthly billing requirements apply.

DTI 800/888 (Inbound) Long Distance Service

DTI 800/888 (Inbound) Long Distance Service is offered to residential and business customers. The service permits inbound 800/888 calling at a single per minute rate. Service is provided from presubscribed, dedicated or shared use access lines. Calls are billed in six second increments, with a six second minimum call duration. A \$10.00 minimum monthly billing requirement applies. Customers whose monthly usage is less than the minimum will be billed the minimum amount.

DTI Calling Card Service

DTI Calling Card Service is a calling card service offered to residential and business customers who subscribe to the DTI Long Distance Service calling plan. Customers using the Carrier's calling card service access the service by dialing a 1-800 number followed by an account identification number and the number being called. This service permits subscribers utilizing the Carrier's calling card to make calls at a single per minute rate. Calls are billed in one (1) minute increments after the initial minimum period of one (1) minute. There are no nonrecurring or monthly recurring charges.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE continued

DTI Operator Services

The Company's operator services are provided to residential and business customers who "presubscribe" to this service for intrastate calling. Operator services include the completion of collect, station-to-station, person-to-person, third party billing and credit card calls with the assistance of a Carrier operator. Each completed operator assisted call consists of two charge elements (except as otherwise indicated herein): (i) a fixed operator charge, which will be dependent on the type of billing selected (e.g., calling card, collect or other) and/or the completion restriction selected (e.g., station-to-station or person-toperson); and (ii) a measured usage charge dependent upon the duration, distance and/or time of day of the call.

DTI Operator Dialed Surcharge

This surcharge applies to calls when the customer has the capability of dialing all the digits necessary to complete a call, but elects to dial only the appropriate operator code and requests the operator to dial the called station. The surcharge does not apply to:

- Calls where a customer cannot otherwise dial the call due to defective equipment or trouble on the DTI Telecom network; and
- 2) Calls in which a Company operator places a call for a calling party who is identified as being handicapped and unable to dial the call because of his/her handicap.

The Operator Dialed Surcharge applies in addition to any other applicable operator charges.

3.2 **Rates**

The following must be included:

- Current Prices
- Customer connection charges
- 3.2.1 DTI Long Distance Service

Rate per minute - \$0.25. Plan is billed in full minute increments.

2.2.3 DTI 800/888 (Inbound) Long Distance Service

Rate per minute - \$0.25. Plan is billed in six second increments with a six second minimum.

3.2.4 DTI Calling Card Service

Rate per minute - \$0.25. Plan is billed in full minute increments.

3.2.5 DTI Operator Services (For presubscribed customers)

3.2.6 <u>Usage Rates</u>: The appropriate rate found under 4.1 or 4.3 shall apply.

SECTION 3 - RATES continued

3.3 Determining Applicable Rate in Effect

For the initial minute, the rate applicable at the start of chargeable time at the calling station applies. For additional minutes, the rate applicable is that rate which is in effect at the calling station when the additional minute(s) begin. That is, if chargeable time begins during the Day Period, the Day Rate applies to the initial minute and to any additional minutes that the call continues during the rate period. If the call continues into a different rate period, the appropriate rates from that period apply to any additional minutes occurring in that rate period. If an additional minute is split between two rate periods, the rate period applicable at the start of the minute applies to the entire minute.

3.4 Payment of Calls

3.4.1 Late Payment Charges

A late payment Charge of 1.5% per month will be assessed on all unpaid balances more than thirty days old.

3.4.2 Return Check Charges

A return check charge of \$35.00 will be assessed for checks returned for insufficient funds if the face value does not exceed \$50.00, \$30.00 if the face value does exceed \$50.00 but does not Exceed \$300.00, \$45.00 if the face value exceeds \$300.00 or 5% of the value of the check, which ever is greater.

3.5 Restoration of Service

A reconnection fee of \$35.00 per occurrence is charged when service is re-established for customers who had been disconnected for non-payment.

3.6 **Telecommunications Relay Service**

For calls received from the relay service, the Company will when billing relay calls discount relay service calls by 50 percent off of the otherwise applicable rate for a voice non-relay call except that where either the calling or called party indicates that either party is both hearing and visually impaired, the call shall be discounted 60 percent off of the otherwise applicable rate for a voice non-relay call.
