On October 26, 2005, BellSouth Telcommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) requested additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Sanford exchange, Lake Mary (LKMRFLHEDS0) switch. BellSouth requested two (2) specific NXX-Xs for two (2) specific customer's requests of 500 and 100 numbers. One customer requested the format NXX-84XX or 55XX and another customer requested anything other than the format NXX-0XXX or 9XXX. Also on October 26, 2005, BellSouth's request for additional numbering resources was denied by NeuStar because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for new blocks of numbers.
