

To the Clerk,

Per the above Docket and Order, Residential Water Systems, Inc. was to have completed replacement of all **535** 5/8-inch and **168** 1-inch meters by December 31, 2005.

As of November 30, 2005 the replacement program is **60%** completed. Of a total 708 customers, 422 meters, comprised of **314** 5/8-inch and **108** 1-inch, have been replaced or installed.

Residential Water Systems, Inc. respectfully requests an amendment to the above Order for an extension of time to allow completion of the meter replacement program. Our extension estimate is for an additional 24 months to December 31, 2007.

The main reason for the delay has been a combination lack of available labor, along with maintenance requirements for the entire 1500 customer base. Marion County has the lowest unemployment rate in the State and as a result it has been extremely difficult finding any kind of manual labor.
