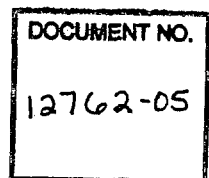

**REPORT OF THE PARTIES**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(f) and this Court's initial scheduling order, attorneys for the parties held a conference call on February 9, 2000, attended by:

Raoul G. Cantero, III and Sean Lev  
on behalf of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.

Carolyn Raeppe, Jeffrey Rackow, and Lara Flint  
on behalf of MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC

Martha Carter Brown  
on behalf of the Florida Public Service Commission defendants

At that meeting, the parties agreed to request that the Court revise the initial scheduling order by adopting the following procedure and schedule:

1. Nature of Proceeding. Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(e), the Court is sitting in review of a PSC order under the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The issues under review are whether BellSouth should be obligated to provide defendant

MCI Metro Access Transmission Services, LLC ("MCI") access to a combination of two of BellSouth's local exchange network elements at the sum of the unbundled network element prices for those two elements; and whether BellSouth must refund to MCI part of the price MCI paid for use of a service that MCI has ordered since November 1997.

2. Possibility of Settlement. The parties agree that settlement is unlikely, and that mediation would not be helpful in resolving the issues in dispute.

3. Revisions to Initial Scheduling Order. The parties agree that due to the nature of these proceedings, the Court should adopt an appellate-style briefing schedule with an opportunity for oral argument. Accordingly, the parties request that the court adjust the Initial Scheduling Order as follows:

- a. Plaintiff's initial brief shall be served by June 14, 2000.
- b. Defendants' answer briefs shall be served by July 17, 2000.
- c. Plaintiff's reply brief shall be served by August 10, 2000.

The parties have further agreed to a 50-page limit for initial and answer briefs, and a 25-page limit for the reply brief.

4. Discovery Requirements. The parties agree that no discovery is required and that review in this court should be limited to the record below, and argument of counsel. The parties stipulate that disclosures pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 26(a)(1) and 26(a)(2) are not required.


5. Trial. The parties agree that no trial is necessary, and that the Court should decide this matter on the pleadings and record in this action, the briefs of the

parties, and argument of counsel. The parties further agree that oral argument is necessary for a fair determination of the issues. Finally, the parties request that oral argument be set as soon after August 10, 2000 as the Court's calendar permits.

6. Record on Appeal. The parties agree that the entire record below shall be transmitted to the Court. The clerk of the PSC shall provide the parties with an index to the record on appeal by May 31, 2000. To the extent that documents contained in the record were deemed confidential and submitted to the PSC under seal, the respective parties will request that this Court also maintain those confidential documents under seal. The parties agree that the record to be submitted to the court in this case includes the materials filed in PSC Docket No. 981121-TP. In addition, the parties agree that the consolidated record of the underlying arbitration proceedings in PSC Docket Nos. 960846-TP, 960833-TP and 960916-TP, and the record materials filed in the related proceedings in PSC Docket No. 971140-TP, are properly a part of the record in this case and the parties reserve the right to make supplemental designations to the materials filed in those dockets.


7. Manual for Complex Litigation. The parties agree that this matter should not be made subject to the Manual for Complex Litigation.






