Complaints.

On September 29, 2005, Docket No. 050682-TX was established to investigate Saluda Networks Incorporated's (Saluda) apparent violation of Rule 25-22.032(6)(b), F.A.C., Customer Complaints. By Order No. PSC-05-1164-PAA-TX, issued November 22, 2005, the Commission penalized Saluda in the amount of \$40,000. The Commission further ordered that this docket should be closed either upon receipt of the payment of the penalty within fourteen calendar days after the issuance of the Consummating Order or upon the cancellation of the company's certificate. Consummating Order PSC-05-1235-CO-TX was issued on December 19, 2005, making Order No. PSC-05-1164-PAA-TX final and effective. On December 27, 2005, an Amendatory Order, PSC-05-1235A-CO-TX, was issued to clarify a scrivener's error. The amendatory order that was issued did not change the Commission's orders as stated in Order No. PSC-05-1164-PAA-TX.

Fourteen calendar days have elapsed since the issuance of the Consummating Order and the company has not submitted its payment; therefore, Certificate No. 8376 should be cancelled and this docket should be closed administratively.
