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Exhibit "A"

The former Majority Shareholder (Ronald Chase 52%) has encountered medical problems associated with Alzheimer's disease. His Father (Sid Wingerhoff), age 86, was appointed as the executor of the son's estate. Given the expense of maintaining care for his son, Mr. Wingerhoff indicated that he would be agreeable to selling his son's interest in the utility. An agreement in principle was reached with the Buyers (Floyd & Eugenia Segarra and Charles deMenzes) subject to the normal conditions of purchasing stock in an S Corporation, which included requiring the provision of the Stock Certificate, Stock Book and Utility PSC Certificate to the Buyers. The agreement called for a purchase of the 52% interest for One Hundred Forty Thousand (\$140,000.00) Dollars and repayment of a corporate loan in the amount of Ten Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Four (\$10,634.00) Dollars.

Mr. Chase originally maintained the documents required, but because of his medical condition, he was not able to provide the information. The Buyers subsequently had to re-create the corporate information, which included the Stock Book and Stock Certificates. The transaction was eventually closed on August 31, 2005.

In addition, Mr. John Fannon, the other Stockholder, indicated his willingness to sell his interest in the utility, as he was not in a position to invest more funds in the utility as required. (Exhibit "D")

An Agreement was reached with Mr. Fannon to purchase his interest (24%) for Sixty Five Thousand (\$65,000.00) Dollars. Purchase of Mr. John Fannon's interest by the Buyers was also consummated on August 31, 2005.

The purchase is in the public interest as Charles deMenzes, one of the Buyers has been managing this utility since 1989. In addition, Mr. deMenzes has three (3) other water and/or wastewater utilities, which he has owned or managed for over 20 years.

The Buyers will fulfill the commitments, obligations and representations of the Sellers with regard to utility matters.

Exhibit "B"

Stock Purchase Agreement

This agreement between Ronald Chase (Sid Wingerhoff POA), hereinafter known as "Seller" and ChHE/ES dE MENCES, hereinafter known as "Buyer" stipulates that the Seller is willing to sell and the Buyer is willing to buy the seller's interest in the Corporation known as C.F.A.T. H2o, Inc., a Florida corporation.

Seller represents that said interest in the corporation equals one hundred four (104) shares of stock, representing fifty-two (52%) percent of the corporation, and that Seller has the right to sell said interest which Seller warrants that the Stock is free of any and all liens or encumbrances.

Purchase price for said shares of stock is One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00) payable in cash within 30 days of the signing of this agreement.

Effective date of purchase shall be August 31st, 2005.

Seller shall sign and transfer said stock certificate representing Seller's interest and tender said certificate to buyer upon payment of purchase price by Buyer. Because the original Corporate Book and Stock Certificates are not available, a duplicate set has been re-created and Seller agrees to sign any additional documents necessary to effectuate the stock transfer as required.

In addition, Seller hereby resigns as President of C.F.A.T. H2o, Inc. effective immediately.

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The Buyers have not financed the purchase from the Sellers. Funds were provided from personal assets.

Exhibit "D"

Mr. deMenzes, one of the Buyers, has been managing the utility system since 1989.

There is no Outstanding Notice of Violations of any standards set by DEP.

System Improvements the Buyers are executing:

- As required by DEP, systems serving more than 100 households should have two potable wells. An attempt to activate the utilities 2nd well failed due to Sulfur and Turbidity problems. As a result a permit was obtained from SMFWD to drill another well. This well has been drilled and application has been made to DEP for approval to activate the new well.
- 2. The utility has an agreement to service additional customers in the certificated area and as a result the utility must upgrade it's water plant to meet Marion County code. The utility has contracted with Florida-Aquastore & Utility Construction, Inc. to provide and install a 200,000-gallon ground potable water tank. An application for this ground tank has been submitted to DEP and the utility is waiting for approval.
- 3. Along with the above improvements, the entire electrical system had to be replaced and improved at the water plant site. The electrical work has been done and should be activated by the end of January 2006.

The above improvements are currently being executed and should be completed by the 1st quarter of 2006. Funds for these improvements are provided by Amsouth Bank as a 1st Mortgage on the utility property and personally guaranteed by the Mr. deMenzes.
