Dear Ms. Brubaker:

In September, 2004 DeSoto County and Lake Suzy Utility, Inc. ("Company") entered into an agreement that addressed the provision of public water and wastewater services to the residents of DeSoto County. In the agreement, the County was to be the water provider, and Lake Suzy was to be the wastewater provider for a large portion of the County. An application to the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC") was duly filed, and ultimately approved. Since that time, the parties have entered into various discussions aimed at modifying the transaction approved by the FPSC. These negotiations have focused on the County entering into an interlocal agreement with neighboring Charlotte County, in which a residential developer (US Homes) will be responsible for constructing an approximate two mile sewer line that will transmit wastewater from DeSoto County to Charlotte County for treatment and disposal. Once that agreement is finalized between the two counties, DeSoto will then enter into an agreement with Lake Suzy allowing it to transmit its wastewater from new development that will occur within its franchise. In addition, it is anticipated that the parties will continue their relationship for the purchase of bulk water from the Peace River Water Authority, and will execute an amendment to the September, 2004 agreement.

It is anticipated that negotiation between Charlotte and DeSoto Counties and subsequent negotiation between DeSoto County and the Company will conclude in approximately four months. To accommodate the time needed to finalize the negotiation between the Counties and the Company and file the resulting documents with the Commission, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission keep the above-referenced docket open through May 31, 2006.
