Notification by Telrite Corporation and Line 1 Communications, LLC

d/b/a Direct Line Communications of a Transfer of Control

Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of Line 1 Communications, LLC d/b/a Direct Line Communications ("Direct Line)" and Telrite Corporation ("Telrite") (together referred to as the "Parties"), this letter is to advise the Commission of an Asset Purchase Agreement whereby Telrite will acquire substantially all of the local and long distance customer accounts of Direct Line (the "Acquisition").

It is our understanding, based upon review of the applicable statutes and regulations, that this transaction does not require prior Commission approval. Accordingly, absent written notice to the contrary within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, the parties will proceed to consummate the transaction in a timely fashion. The Parties are also requesting that the Commission waive the verification requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 25-4.118.

After the transaction is consummated, the Direct Line local and long distance customers will be served by Telrite with the same services and rates as previously provided by Direct Line. Direct Line will continue to offer VOIP services to customers in the State of Florida after consummation of the transaction and therefore will maintain its long distance certification in Florida.

Direct Line is authorized to provide local, intrastate, interstate and international long distance telecommunication services in 19 states. Direct Line is a certificated provider of

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resold long distance services in this State.¹ Telrite Corporation is a Georgia Corporation which provides long distance in 48 states. Telrite is a certificated provider of resold long distance services in this State.²

The proposed transaction will accomplish the following:

The proposed transaction will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity. Consummation of the proposed transaction will result in net benefits to all of Direct Line's customers by creating a single, larger provider of telecommunications services, facilitating efficiencies to benefit all of Direct Line's and Telrite's customers. The transaction will enhance Telrite's ability to offer a broader range of innovative products and services to customers.

The customers of Direct Line will be given the opportunity to switch their service from Direct Line to a different carrier. None of the customers of Direct Line will experience any change in rates due to the Acquisition. To the extent that any of Direct Line's rates are not presently included in Telrite's tariffs, Telrite will amend its Tariffs accordingly to include such rates. As a result, the transaction should not cause any inconvenience or confusion to the existing customers of Direct Line. Those customers of Direct Line who choose not to switch their service to a different carrier will receive service from Telrite.

The Commission's ability and authority to regulate Direct Line and to ensure that it satisfies all obligations, commitments and regulatory requirements established by the laws of this state and the Commission will remain unchanged. Thus, there are no potential public interest concerns raised by the proposed transaction and there will be clear benefits to the public upon the closing of this transaction.

The parties are forwarding this letter to the Commission for informational purposes, to be included in the appropriate files. Absent receipt of written notification to the contrary within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, we will proceed with the understanding that no approval or other formal action is required by the Commission prior to consummation of the proposed transaction.
