Re: Protest of Docket No. 050819-WU- Request to establish new class of service for RV Park in Lee County, by Tamiami Village Water Company, Inc.

Dear Ms. Flynn;

Tamiami Master Association is the owner of Tamiami RV Park located in Lee County. As the owner we take umbrage in the way this request was handled. We were not notified of the request to change class of service for the RV Park until it was already approved by the Commission. We have been notified about rate increases in the past, after the increase has been approved by the Public Service Commission, which from our understanding is allowed pursuant to Section 367.081 (4) (a) Florida Statutes. However, in requesting a new classification, we should have been notified by either the Commission or Tamiami Village Water Company, Inc., before the Commission made a ruling. This is a request that adversely affects one of the water company's largest customers and notification should have been given to us regarding the request prior to the item being placed on the Commission's docket.

This protest is primarily based on the incorrect numbers given to the commission regarding the meter and the customers in the RV Park. The RV Park is also a commercial endeavor; why should it be compared to residential rates? Tamiami Water Company's request for change of classification of one meter involves an 822.75 percent increase for basic service charge, we believe that's just for basic service and does not include the cost of the water.

The RV Park only has 16 permanent full time RV's, 73 permanent part times (50% of year, maximum 6 month stay) and the other 155 RV transit lots occupied 40% of the time.

Please consider amending your decision regarding the approved fee. We still believe that since this is an RV Park and commercial venture that a more equitable charge and increase should be examined. Also if the Tamiami Village Water Company, Inc entered
