Staff believes that Sprint's Motion fails to identify any points of fact or law that the Commission overlooked or failed to consider in its decisions as to Issues 5, 21, 22, and 24. However, Sprint's Motion does identify certain aspects of the Order on Arbitration that should be clarified or amended, as set forth in the analysis portion of staff's February 17, 2006 memorandum. Accordingly, staff recommends that the Commission on its own motion clarify its decisions on Issues 21 and 24.

The motion for reconsideration is denied. Issue 24 will not be clarified. Italy's recommendation on Issue 22 is denied; the motion for reconsideration will be granted. The recommendation on Issues 5 and 21 is approved.
