As we discussed on the phone, below please find a series of staff's data requests regarding the above mentioned petition. We would appreciate answers to these questions by March 24, 2006.

1. According to Commission Order PSC-04-0769-PAA-EG, the RIM values for Progress's Home Energy Improvement, Residential New Construction, Low Income Weatherization Assistance, Better Business and C/I New Construction programs are; 1.05, 1.28, 1.01, 1.20, and 1.20, respectively. Upon how many customers per year, per program, were these analyses based?
2. According to Progress's petition, the modified programs listed above have RIM values of 1.12, 1.53, 1.05, 1.15, and 1.12. Upon how many customers per year, per program, were these analyses based?
3. What role did the new federal manufacturing standards that became effective January 23, 2006 play in the petition to modify these programs? Explain.
4. Did Progress provide any additional incentives for customers participating in conservation programs that were not listed in the petition? Explain.
5. According to the petition, The Better Business Program is an umbrella program that provides incentives for a variety of cost-effective efficiency measures on existing commercial and industrial facilities. If the RIM value was set at 1.0, would this allow Progress to capture more cost-effective measures? Explain.
6. What effect will the program modifications have on the conservation goals that the Commission set for Progress? Explain.

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7. What is the additional cost per program as a result of the increase in the incentives?
8. What process does Progress have in place to monitor these programs to see that they are and continue to be cost-effective?
