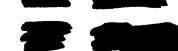

Related Party Allocations and Transactions

105.1 - Bulk Water Extension WIP

CWU paid RAF a total of \$2,277 in 2005 for locating utilities for the interconnect construction and installing a temporary water line. Rates were based on the hourly rates RAF charges other companies for similar services.

CWU agreed to pay TDI and it's successor, LPL, a fee of 15% of the total project cost of the interconnect project consisting of Conceptual Design and Feasibility project management from 1998 to 1999; Bulk Water negotiations with the City of Ocala from June 2000 through Sept 2003; and Design and construction management from 2002 to 2006.

601 and 603 - Salaries and Wages

In 1993, we participated in an overearnings investigation that resulted in no change to our rates. At the time of that investigation, CWU had no employees and our related company, Squadron 567 Corp., (567) along with Environmenters Water and Wastewater, Inc. managed all operations. During the investigation, 567 summarized the duties of each employee and determined that Dirk and Becca spent approximately 20% of their time working on CWU activities and Jim about 5% of his time. At this time CWU had 330 customers.

In 1997, CWU had 366 customers and hired Dirk, Becca, and Jim as employees and reduced 567's contract to only computer services, automobile use, and plant site landscape maintenance. At that time, Becca was earning the ber week () of the US Average Wage Rate) and her salary was set at \$100 per week, the of her total wages. Dirk's earned income averaged about () between 1995 and 1996 and his salary was set at \$350 per week or about () of that average. Jim's salary was the per week based on 2 hours per week at the per hour.

In 2005, Becca's total wages were the per week (100 of the US Average Wage Rate). While the US Average Wage increased by 55% between 1993 and 2005, the allowable price indexing of CWU's rates was only 28%. And although CWU now has 472 customers, about 43% more customers than in 1993, CWU could not afford to pay more than 1990 of her total salary. Dirk's average earned income now exceeds 1990 per year and his 2005 CWU salary was only \$404 per week or less than 1990 of his total because CWU could not afford to pay more. Jim's salary is currently \$92 per week or hours at the per hour.

After analyzing our employees' hours spent on utility business as requested in Item 2 of Document Request #2 (see Attachment "C"), we found that salary allocations are far below the amount of work performed and believe a pro-forma adjustment should be made to set salaries at the following rates:

Becca — or \$413 per week
Dirk — or \$1,868 per week

Jim — Thours per week at per hour or \$180 per week

Because of the non-routine work that Jim performs such as consulting on matters such as financing, contracts, capital improvements, planning and budgeting, we could not perform a thorough analysis of Jim's time.

604 – Employee Pensions and Benefits

CWU currently contributes 4% of the employees' wages under a SARSEP plan to each employee's IRA. IRS rules require that this percentage be consistent among related companies.

Employees started receiving paid health insurance in 2005. CWU's allocation was based on the total amount paid for Becca and Dirk and for Jim. This percentage was based on the 1993 hour analysis adjusted for the increase in customers. Our pro-forma request is to match the percentages determined in Attachment "C".

620 - Materials and Supplies

In consideration of a reduced rent and utility reimbursement rate from RAF, CWU does not get charged for any normal office supplies. RAF bills CWU for postage at cost. RAF charges CWU for use of the copier at \$0.15 per copy.

620.74 Telephone

CWU is charged \$20 per month by LPL for Dirk's cell phone usage and \$5 per month by RAF for long distance on the line that does not have call accounting. CWU pays for long distance on the line with call accounting at cost.

630.06 - Repairs and Maintenance

RAF is under contract to provide water plant site landscape maintenance. This service under the contract with RAF was terminated in November, 2005 when the interconnect was activated and the land and equipment lease was terminated. The amount was originally \$100 per month in 1993 and was a fair market rate based on quotes from other lawn service companies. It has been indexed since that time.

630.50 - Computer and Accounting Expense

RAF charges CWU for the use of computers and software, ink, toner, paper, accounting support, and computer support at the rate of the support at the s

640 - Rents

Office Rent - In consideration of a reduced rent and utility reimbursement rate from RAF, CWU gets to use office furniture, file cabinets, office machines, telephone system, postage meter, etc. at no charge. CWU is reimbursed by RAF for 50% of the office rent and utilities.

Generator Rent – Dirk purchased a backup generator and rented it to CWU for use at the water plant. This lease was terminated in November, 2005 when the interconnect was activated. The current rental rate of \$126.45 was based on the value of the generator and a reasonable Cap Rate and was indexed.

Land and Equipment Rent – BOI owns the water plant site and equipment building where spare parts were stored and the generator was located. This lease was terminated in November, 2005 when the interconnect was activated. The current rental rate of \$187 per month was set in 1993 based on FMV of the land and building and a reasonable Cap Rate and was never indexed.
