Dear Chairman Edgar:

This letter, pursuant to Rule 25-30.430, Florida Administrative Code, requests approval of a test year for Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven ("Company"). The Company intends to submit an application for general rate relief to the Florida Public Service Commission for its wastewater system located in Charlotte County, Florida. The Company intends to submit the minimum filing requirements ("MFRs") on or before June 30, 2006.

The Company's last rate proceeding was in Docket No. 020409-SU, utilizing a test year ending December 31, 2001, which culminated in Order No. PSC-03-0602-PAA-SU, on May 13, 2003. That Order was declared final in Order No. PSC-03-0677-CO-SU, dated June 4, 2003.

The Company requests a historic test year ending December 31, 2005. The requested test year is representative of a normal full year of operation. The Company will be interconnecting with the Englewood Water District at the end of 2006, at which time it will abandon its existing wastewater treatment plant and obtain wastewater treatment and disposal in bulk from Englewood Water District. The new rates will need to consider this major change in operational methods.



The Company proposes to make major pro forma plant additions, primarily in connection with interconnecting with the Englewood Water District. The MFRs will include pro forma adjustments for increases in salaries and salary-related benefits, purchased power and other costs, which will be requested in this proceeding. Some pro formas are growth related and others are not growth related.

Pursuant to Section 367.081(8), Florida Statutes, the Company requests that the Commission process this petition for rate relief using the proposed agency action procedure. The Company also will request interim rates based on the historic test year.
