06/20/05 - Received from Patrick Crocker a copy of TJ850, Axius Communications' FCC application for authority to discontinue long distance in Florida and other areas of the country. The letter did not specifically request cancellation.

06/22/05 - E-mailed Crocker and asked if the company wanted to request cancellation.

10/11/05 - E-mailed Crocker and asked again.

11/17/05 - Called company and left voice mail message asking the question.

11/21/05 - Angela Webb from company called and left a voice mail message advising yes, they do want to cancel.

11/21/05 - Called Angela Webb and advised they needed to pay the 2005 RAF. I e-mailed the 2005 Regulatory Assessment Fee return to her.

As of today, payment of the 2005 RAF has not been received. Crocker has never contacted me back.

Should I open a docket to cancel the certificate even though I do not have a letter specifically requesting cancellation, only a telephone call? If yes, what is the effective date?

Or should I wait until after delinquent notices are mailed and if they don't pay, cancel with all the others?

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING REGULATORY ASSESSMENT FEE RETURN
(Interexchange Company)

1. **WHEN TO FILE:** For companies which owed a total of **\$10,000 or more** of assessment fee for the preceding calendar year, this Regulatory Assessment Fee Return and payment is required twice a year and payment must be filed or postmarked:

*On or before July 30 for the six-month period January 1 through June 30, and
On or before January 30 for the six-month period July 1 through December 31.*

For companies which owed a total of **less than \$10,000** of assessment fee for the preceding calendar year, this Regulatory Assessment Fee Return and payment must be filed or postmarked:

On or before January 30 for the twelve-month period January 1 through December 31.

However, if July 30 or January 30 falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, the Regulatory Assessment Fee may be filed or postmarked on the next business day, without penalty.

2. **FEES:** Each company shall pay 0.0020 of its gross operating revenues derived from intrastate business, as referenced in Rule 25-4.0161(1), F.A.C. Gross Operating Revenues are defined as the total revenues before expenses. Gross Intrastate Operating Revenues are defined as revenues from calls originating and terminating within Florida. Do not deduct any expenses, taxes, or uncollectibles from these amounts other than the amount in Line 7.

On Line 7, deduct any amounts paid to a telecommunications company for the use of any telecommunications network to provide service to its customers. **Do not deduct** any taxes, federal subscriber line charges, interstate long distance access charges, or amounts paid for nonregulated services such as voice mail, inside wire maintenance, or equipment purchases/rentals. **DEDUCTIONS MUST BE INTRASTATE ONLY AND MUST BE VERIFIABLE.**

3. **FAILURE TO FILE BY DUE DATE:** Failure to file a return by the established due date will result in a penalty being added to the amount of fee due, 5% for each 30 days or fraction thereof, not to exceed a total penalty of 25% (Line 10). In addition, interest shall be added in the amount of 1% for each 30 days or fraction thereof, not to exceed a total of 12% per year (Line 11). A Regulatory Assessment Fee Return must be completed, signed, and filed even if there are no revenues to report or if the minimum amount is due.

When a company fails to timely file a Regulatory Assessment Fee Return, the Commission has the authority to order the company to pay a penalty and/or remove the company from the list of companies registered to provide service. The company will have an opportunity to respond to any proposed Commission action.

4. **EXTENSION:** A request for an extension of time up to 30 days may be made by filing the enclosed *Regulatory Assessment Fee Extension Request* form (PSC/CCA 124), two weeks prior to the filing date. When an extension is granted, a charge shall be added to the amount due (Line 12):

0.75% of the fee to be remitted for an extension of 15 days or less, or
1.5% of the fee for an extension of 16 to 30 days.

In lieu of paying the charges outlined above, a company may file a return and remit payment based upon estimated gross operating revenues. If such return is filed by the normal due date, the company shall be granted a 30-day extension period in which to file and remit the actual fee due without paying the above charges, provided the estimated fee payment remitted is at least 90% of the actual fee due for the period. An automatic 30-day extension to file an actual return may be obtained by checking the "Estimated Return" space in the top left-hand corner on the reverse side.

5. **FEE ADJUSTMENTS:** You will be notified as to the amount and reason for any fee adjustment. Penalty and interest charges may be applicable to additional amounts owed the Commission by reason of the adjustment. The company may file a written request for a refund of any overpayments. The request should be directed to Fiscal Services at the below-referenced address.

AXIUS, Inc. d/b/a AXIUS Communications ("AXIUS") hereby files this Application requesting authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and pursuant to Section 63.71 of the code of Federal Regulations to discontinue its domestic and international long distance service. These services are carried over underlying networks owned and operated by Qwest and Global Crossing. AXIUS is a nondominant reseller of long distance services.

1. Pursuant to Section 63.71 (b)(1) through (5) (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(1) through (5)), AXIUS submits the following information:

The proposed discontinuance will affect the provision of long distance services in the states of Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia and Wisconsin.

4. Brief description of the type of service affected:

Long distance services.

AXIUS provided written notice to its affected customers by regular mail on May 11, 2005.

6. Nondominance of the carrier with respect to the service being discontinued:

AXIUS is nondominant with respect to the services it proposes to discontinue.


