On April 3, 2006, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) filed BellSouth Telecommunication, Inc. (BellSouth) requested additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Jacksonville exchange, Clay Street (JCVLFLCLDS0) and San Marco (JCVLFLSMDS0) switches. BellSouth requested these numbers to meet a customer's request, specifically two (2) 1,000 blocks of numbers in the format NPA NXX-2 and 4, and five (5) 1,000 blocks of numbers in the format of NPA NXX-1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7. On April 3, 2006, BellSouth's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for new blocks of numbers.

On April 7, 2006, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the BellSouth petition and has determined the following:

1)	The	carrier	has	demonstrated	that	it	has	customers	in	need	of	numbering
	resou	urces;										

- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (April 26, 2006), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Jacksonville exchange, Clay Street (JCVLFLCLDS0) and San Marco (JCVLFLSMDS0) switches. Also, please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Catherine Beard at (850) 413-7080.
