### AT&T OF THE SOUTHERN STATES, LLC'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

AT&T Communication of the Southern States, LLC ("AT&T"), pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006(8), Florida Administrative Code, files this Request for Confidential Classification and states as follows:

1. On February 17, 2006, AT&T filed its responses to the Commission Staffs First Set of Interrogatories. AT&T's responses to interrogatories 7(e) and 7(g) contains confidential proprietary business information belonging to AT&T. In conjunction with

the confidential responses to interrogatories 7(e) and 7(g), AT&T also filed its claim of confidentiality pursuant to Rule 15-22-006(5), Florida Administrative Code.

- AT&T's confidential responses to Staff's interrogatories 7(e) and 7(g) were included in Stipulated Exhibit 4 and admitted to the record at the hearing held March 29 and 30, 2006 in the above referenced dockets.
- 3. Section 364.183 provides that information which meets certain criteria is exempt from public disclosure under Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.
- 4. Section 364.183 provides that confidential proprietary business information is any information that is owned or controlled by a company, is intended to be and is treated by the company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the company's business operations and has not be previously disclosed. Confidential information includes but is not limited to:
  - a) trade secrets
  - b) internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors
  - c) security measures, systems, or procedures
  - d) information concerning bids or other contractual data
  - e) information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information
  - f) employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information.
- 5. The information provided to the Staff in response to interrogatories 7(e) and 7(g) relates to the competitive interests of AT&T and the public disclosure of such information would impair the competitive business and harm the business operations of AT&T. The information provided in the confidential responses to the Staff's interrogatories provides a virtual roadmap to the extent and capacity of AT&T's

interconnection with other carriers. This information, if disclosed would provide competitors with valuable network information belonging to AT&T giving such competitors an artificial advantage in where and how to compete with AT&T. Such disclosure would clear harm AT&T's competitive business interests as well as harm the business operations of AT&T.

- 6.. The information for which confidential classification is sought is intended to be and is treated by AT&T as private and confidential and has not been otherwise publicly disclosed.
- 7. Accordingly, the information should be determined to be proprietary confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.
- 8. Since the information for which confidential classification constitutes virtually the entire document, no line by line explanation is being provided.
- 9. Attached as Attachment A are two copies of the redacted version of AT&T's confidential responses to Staff's interrogatories 7(e) and 7(g).
- 10. Attachment B contains one copy of the confidential responses to interrogatories 7(e) and 7(g) with the confidential information highlighted.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing AT&T respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission grant AT&T's request that the identified information in AT&T's responses to Staff's Interrogatories 7(e) and 7(g) be deemed proprietary confidential business information and be held exempt from public disclosure.
