By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("Progress") provide responses to the following data requests:

- 1. In 1993, Progress installed helper cooling towers (HTCs) on the north bank of the discharge canal at the Crystal River generating site. Please explain why those towers were installed, and please indicate the cost of the towers and the method by which that cost was recovered.
- 2. Please describe the HTCs in terms of size, performance, pump-size, and energy demand. In your response, please compare the size, performance, and cost of the HTCs to the size, performance, and cost of modular cooling towers.
