On February 14, 2006, County-Wide filed a response to a data request made by Division of Economic Regulation (Document No. 01255-06).

On February 17, 2006, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)2., Florida Administrative Code, staff held an audit exit conference with the utility. At this exit conference meeting, County-Wide requested that certain audit working papers be held in a temporary confidential status.

On February 20, 2006, staff filed the sensitive working papers identified at the audit exit conference (Document No. 01451-06).

On March 10, 2006, County-Wide filed a request for confidential classification for certain portions of the response to the data request and for certain portions of the staff working papers presented at the audit exit conference. This request included copies with the sensitive information highlighted (Document No. 02111-06) and public copies with the sensitive information redacted (Document No. 02112-06).

CMP _____ On March 31, 2006, the Division of Economic Regulation (Edwards) filed Document No. 02919-06 which was considered part of the utility's response to the County-Wide data request.

CTR _____ Currently the Bureau of Records and Hearing Services holds document Nos. 01255-06, 01451-06, 02111-06, and 2919-06 in a temporary confidential status awaiting resolution of the County-Wide request for confidential classification.
