Dear Mr. Cox:

Please be advised this firm represents Intercoastal Medical Group, Inc. in regard to its account with Verizon Florida, Inc. It is my understanding that you have been the account representative working with IMG, which is the reason for this correspondence to be directed to you. Copies of the same are being provided to the President of Verizon Florida, Inc. and the Public Service Commission.

IMG is a multi-specialty physician practice group maintaining several offices in Sarasota County, Florida. They have been a customer of Verizon for many years maintaining several business accounts for their various offices. Historically, virtually all of the invoices for CMP telephone service for IMG were directed to their corporate offices at 943 S. Beneva Road, Sarasota, Florida 34232. Several months ago, IMG began working with Verizon in order to COM upgrade their phone service. During the upgrade, Verizon, unilaterally, made several changes CTR that diminished their ability to control their accounts payable functions for the on-going service provided by Verizon. These included the creation of new account numbers for existing phone ECR service accounts, and changing the billing addresses to physical locations to which the telephone **GCL** numbers were directed, from the corporate offices.)PC

As a result of these changes, certain of the bills for services rendered to one of its offices, **ICA** 3333 Cattlemen Road, were not picked up by the accounts payable department of IMG. Rather CR than contacting the principals of IMG with whom Verizon Florida, Inc. had been dealing, or forwarding the same to the traditional billing address at the corporate offices, Verizon elected to GA disconnect service to the Cattlemen Road address. EC

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The Cattlemen Road location houses the offices of several of the physicians as well as laboratory facilities for IMG. The disconnection of phone service to those locations resulted in significant damages to IMG and its patients. It has now been learned by IMG that monies that otherwise should have been directed towards the payment of these bills were instead directed to charges by Verizon Directories, Inc., a separate entity, for Yellow Pages advertising of IMG.

We view the conduct by Verizon Florida, Inc. in this matter as tortious as well as in breach of the fiduciary obligation that Verizon Florida, Inc. owes to its customers. The purpose of this communication is to put you on notice of this claim and that IMG intends to pursue this matter, not only for the damages it has incurred, but for whatever regulatory violations have occurred.
