Re: LRN NPA-NXX for New Gainesville Switch

Dear Ms. Bayó:

US LEC Corp. seeks intervention of the Commission in securing an NPA-NXX assignment for LRN purposes. US LEC Corp., on behalf of US LEC of Florida Inc., recently requested a new NPA-NXX for the Gainesville rate center from Neustar. The request was for an NPA-NXX to support a new US LEC switch, GSVLFLSMFMD that will be delivered to 400 SW 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave., Gainesville, FL 32601. US LEC does not have the NPA-NXX resources in the Gainesville LATA sufficient to provide a unique NPA-NXX to support the new switch LRN. In the request, US LEC notified Neustar that US LEC would retain 1 thousands block from the NXX to support the LRN needs and a provide a small group of numbers for customers and return the remaining blocks to the pool for other local carriers to use.

In its request, US LEC notified Neustar that the request was for an NXX to support an LRN (see paragraph 1.2 on Part 1A and on page 2 of 2 of the *Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet*). In its response, Neustar stated, "Your utilization calculates to 65.180 percent. The FCC requires a utilization of 75.000 percent."

US LEC requests that the Commission intervene on its behalf to secure an LRN NXX in the 352 NPA from Neustar. In accordance with ATIS Guidelines IN 980713-021, LRN Assignment Practice, a company can request the Commission to override the utilization requirement in instances of a need for an NXX for LRN purposes in a new switch. Enclosed are copies of the pages containing US LEC's request and Neustar's response with certain portions highlighted.

## Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN)are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia<sup>TM</sup> LERG<sup>TM</sup> Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia<sup>TM</sup> Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI TM tandem of the facilities based provider vii. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. The also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Initial requests are for first applications for thousands-blocks in a rate center, growth for additional thousands-blocks in a rate center in which the applicant already has numbering resources, and provide the required evidence as ordered by the FCC.

The thousands-block applicant certifies veracity of this form by signing their name, and providing their title and date.

Since multiple OCNs and/or Company Codes may be associated with a given company, companies with prior assignments should direct questions regarding appropriate OCN usage to (TRA) (732-699-6700).
- <sup>iv</sup> This is an eleven-character descriptor of the switch provided by the owning entity for the purpose of routing calls. This is the 11 character CLL!<sup>TM</sup>code of the switch /POI.
