Dear Ms. Mollerup:

On May 2, 2006, the Commission voted on staff's recommendation dated April 20, 2006. A Proposed Agency Action (PAA) order was issued on May 22, 2006. If no protests are filed by the end of the protest period, which is 21 days from the date that the PAA order is issued, the rates and charges approved by this Commission will become final. However, the utility must submit revised tariff pages for staff's approval before the utility can implement new rates.

To expedite the tariff revision process, the utility should file all revised tariff pages by June 5, 2006, to allow staff sufficient time to verify the accuracy of the revised pages. Enclosed are examples of revised tariffs for this utility. Although staff has prepared revised tariffs for this utility, it is the utility's responsibility to make sure all tariffs submitted to the Commission are complete and accurate.

A copy of the staff approved customer notice informing the utility's customers of the Commission's approved increase is also enclosed. This notice must be mailed to customers of receipt prior to consumption at the increased rates.



Notice is hereby given that by Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-06-0444-PAA-WU, issued May 22, 2006, the Florida Public Service Commission approved an increase in water rates for Brendenwood Water System, Inc. (Brendenwood or utility). Pursuant to Rule 25-30.360, Florida Administrative Code, the revenue increase will be collected subject to refund with interest, for a period of 15 months after the filing of the utility's annual report for the year the adjustment in rates was implemented. If there is no protest to the PAA Order by June 12, 2006, the rates will be approved as final rates and become effective for service rendered on or after June 13, 2006. If there is a timely protest, the utility may implement the rates established in the PAA Order on a temporary basis upon the utility filing a staff assisted rate case application within 21 days of the date the protest is filed.
