BROWN: By notice issued March 29th, 2006, this 6 time and place was set for a prehearing conference in Docket 7 Number 060220-EC, petition for determination of need for Seminole Generating Station Unit 3 electrical power plant in 8 9 Putnam County by Seminole Electric Cooperative. 10 The purpose of the prehearing conference is set out in the notice. 11 12 COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Thank you. 13 We will now take appearances. 14 MR. GUYTON: Commissioner, my name is Charles Guyton, I'm with the law firm of Squire, Sanders and Dempsey, 215 South 15 16 Monroe Street, Suite 601, Tallahassee, Florida 32301, appearing on behalf of Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc. 17 18 COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Any other appearances on your 19 part? 20 Staff, please. 21 MS. BROWN: Martha Brown on behalf of the Commission. 22 COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Thank you. We will now go into preliminary matters. Ms. Brown, 23 any preliminary matters? 24 25 MS. 24	handling confidential information.
25	MR. GUYTON: No changes.

1	MS. BROWN: No changes.
2	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Section V, prefiled testimony
3	and exhibits; witnesses.
4	MR. GUYTON: We have no changes.
5	MS. BROWN: No changes, Commissioner.
6	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Section VI, order of
7	witnesses.
8	MR. GUYTON: No changes.
9	MS. BROWN: No changes, Commissioner.
10	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Section VII, basic positions.
11	MR. GUYTON: Seminole has no changes.
12	MS. BROWN: No changes, Commissioner.
13	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Section VIII, issues and
14	positions.
15	MR. GUYTON: Seminole has no changes.
16	MS. BROWN: No changes.
17	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Section IX, exhibit list.
18	MR. GUYTON: Seminole would note that for the first
19	exhibit under the column proffered by Seminole should be
20	included there under the column proffered by.
21	MS. BROWN: I'll make that correction to the
22	prehearing order before you sign it.
23	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Thank you. So noted.
24	MS. BROWN: And, Commissioner, if I might interrupt
25	for a second, I wanted to point out that it appears that all of

6	MS. BROWN: None pending.
7	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Section XIII, post-hearing
8	procedures.
9	MS. BROWN: Commissioner, since it appears that the
10	issues in the case are stipulated, it may be appropriate for
11	the Commission to make a bench decision at the hearing. And in
12	that event, no post-hearing filings would be necessary. But
13	since we won't know that in advance, we'll leave it this way in
14	the prehearing order.
15	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Is Seminole okay?
16	MR. GUYTON: Seminole is of a like mind and would
17	encourage a bench decision if the Commission is so inclined.
18	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: We'll decide that at the
19	hearing, correct?
20	MS. BROWN: Yes.
21	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Thank you. Section XIV,
22	rulings.
23	MR. GUYTON: Seminole has no changes.
24	MS. BROWN: No changes.
25	The prehearing officer may want to make a ruling that

1	It a hearing is held, opening statements should not exceed live
2	minutes.
3	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Do you have any objection to
4	that?
5	MR. GUYTON: None at all.
6	COMMISSIONER ARRIAGA: Fine. If that is the case, it
7	will be so ordered, five minutes for the opening statements.
8	Any other matters?
9	MS. BROWN: Not to my knowledge, Commissioner.
10	MR. GUYTON: Seminole has none.

12	matters to address in this prehearing conference, then we will
13	adjourn the meeting.
