Docket No. 060074-WU – Initiation of show cause proceedings against Alturas Utilities, L.L.C. for apparent violation of Rule 25-30.251(2), F.A.C., Record and Report of Interruptions.

Issue 1: Should Alturas Utilities, L.L.C. be ordered to show cause, in writing within 21 days, as to why it should not be fined for failure to notify the Commission of at least six separate interruptions in service that took place during 2005, in apparent violation of Rule 25-30.251(2), Florida Administrative Code?

Recommendation: Yes. Alturas Utilities, L.L.C. should be ordered to show cause, in writing within 21 days, as to why it should not be fined in the amount of \$300 for failure to notify the Commission of at least six separate interruptions in service that took place during 2005, in apparent violation of Rule 25-30.251(2), Florida Administrative Code. The order to show cause should incorporate the conditions as set forth in the analysis portion of staff's May 25, 2006 memorandum. Further, the utility should be reminded of the importance of being courteous to its customers at all times. The utility should also be warned of the importance of complying with all Commission rules and statutes.
