On March 16, 2006, the Commission received a request from Alternative Access Telephone Communications Corp. d/b/a AA Tele-Com (AA Tele-Com), for a voluntary cancellation of its competitive local exchange telecommunications company (CLEC) certificate. Upon investigation, staff found that the company had a compliance action pending in Docket No. 050949-TX. On March 20, 2006, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-06-0229-PAA-TX in Docket No. 050949-TX, made final and effective by Consummating Order No. PSC-06-0290-CO-TX, issued on April 13, 2006, imposing a penalty in the amount of \$10,000 for failure to comply with Florida statutes, to be paid within 14 days of the issuance of the Consummating Order. The company did not protest the Commission's Order or pay the penalty, nor did it pay its 2005 and 2006 Regulatory Assessment Fees, including late payment charges for the year 2005, as required for a voluntary cancellation. Therefore, since the company's CLEC certificate no. \$332 was involuntarily canceled effective April 13, 2006, Docket No. 060245-TX should be closed administratively.
