


FPL is a monopoly. We the consumers have no alternatives, and therefore there is no competition. FPL is also a public company that pays dividends to stockholders and generous salaries to its executives. By what reasoning could PSC staff state that a utility company (Progress) that is a monopoly "is within its right to petition for recovery...costs to maintain the (rate of) return it was otherwise entitled to earn."? (Quote from St. Pete Times 6-15-05 Louis Hau) How is any company granted such entitlement?




