- Commission cannot adequately fulfill this mandate if RIM Test is used as final cost-effectiveness screen for setting conservation goals.

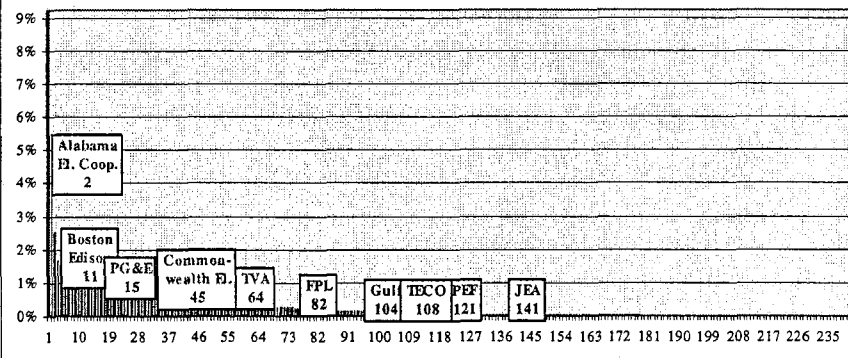

Figure 1-2: Ranking of 2002 Energy Efficiency Program Annual MW Savings as a % of 2002 System Peak Load (MW)

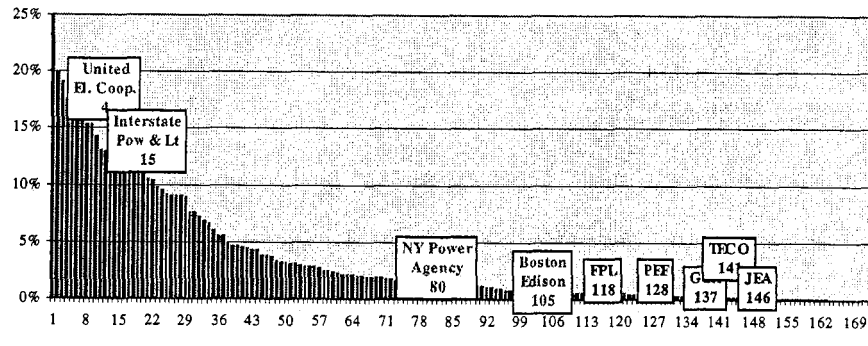


Figure 1-3: Ranking of Energy Efficiency Program Spending in 2002 as a % of 2002 Revenues

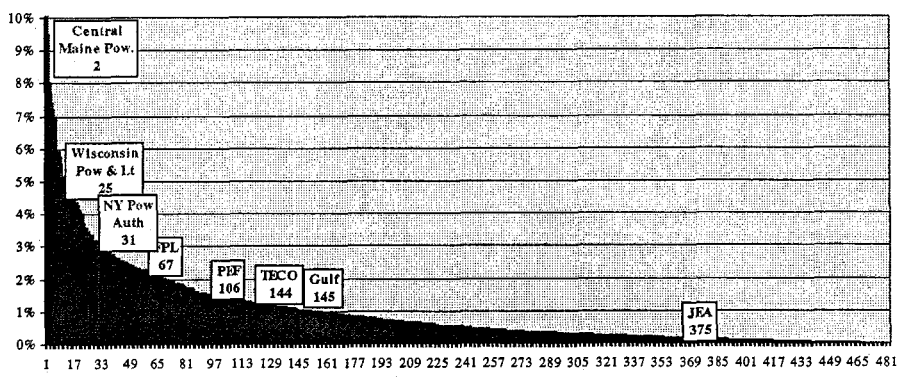


Figure 1-5: Ranking of Penetration of Energy Star Clothes Washers by State - Florida Ranks 35th at 19.7%

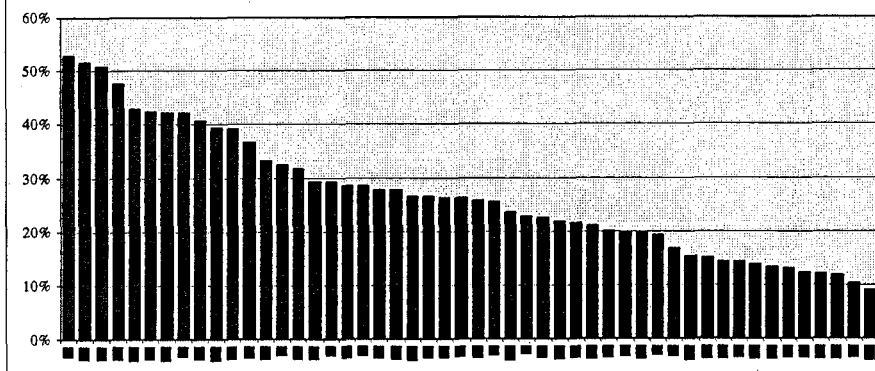
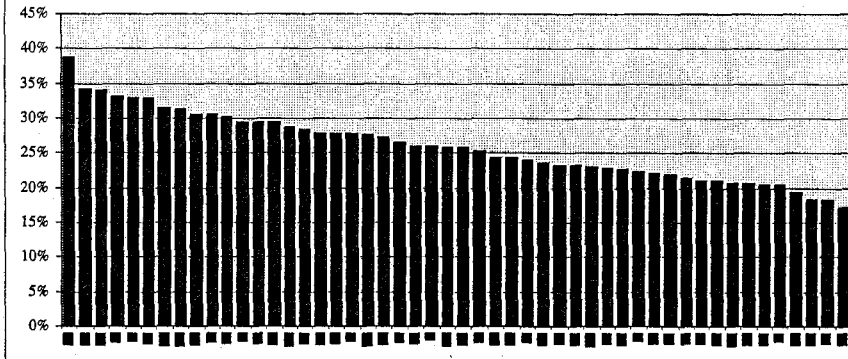


Figure 1-7: Ranking of Penetration of Energy Star Refrigerators by State - Florida Ranks 27th at 25.3%

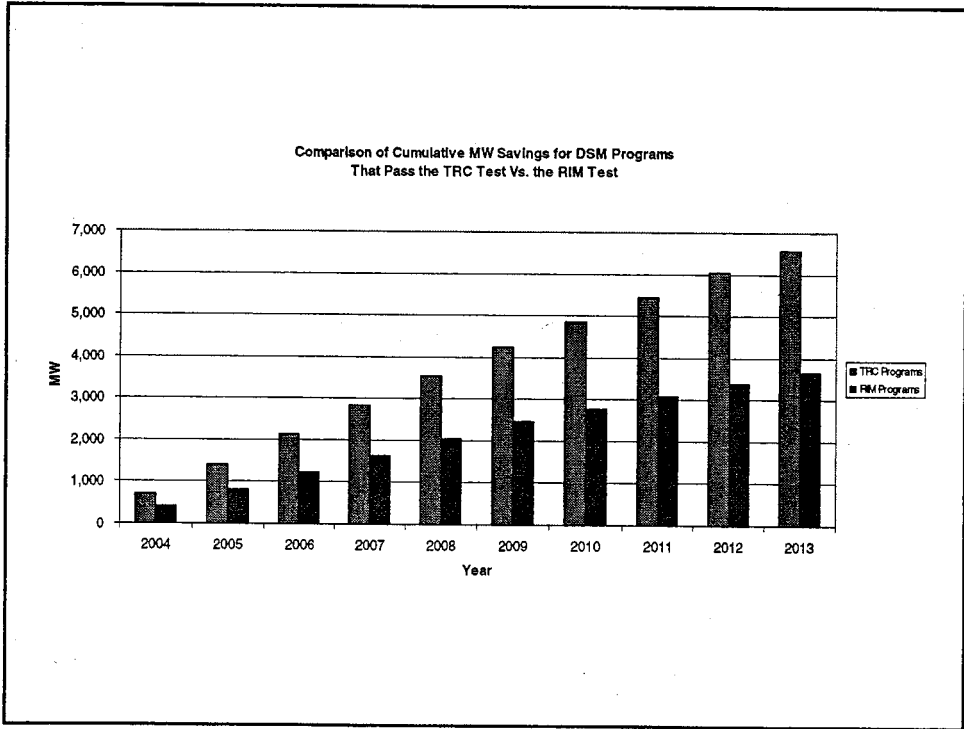
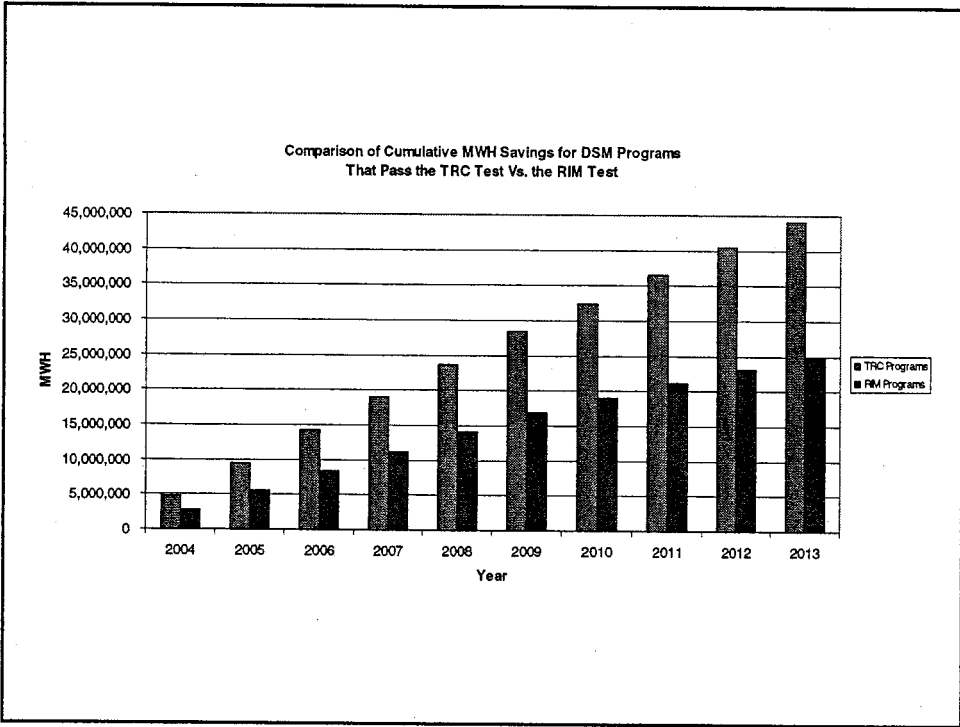


