Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 060477-TL - Petition for expedited review of growth code denials by Number Pooling Administrator for the Orlando

exchange (Magnolia), by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.

On June 15, 2006, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Orlando exchange, Magnolia (ORLDFLMADS1) switch. BellSouth requested four (4) 1,000 consecutive blocks of numbers to meet a customer's request. On June 15, 2006, BellSouth's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for additional numbering resources.

On June 26, 2006, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the BellSouth petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available
