Lance Water should be ordered to submit an original certificate application pursuant to Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.033, Florida Administrative Code, within 60 days from the date of the consummating order. In addition, the utility should be put on notice not to change rates until the jurisdictional status of the utility is resolved. Staff will bring a recommendation to the Commission if it is determined that the current rates should be subject to refund.
