Complaint and request for relief regarding Verizon Florida Inc.'s determination of non-impaired wire centers under the TRRO, by XO Communications Services, Inc.

Dear Ms. Bayo:

On May 1, 2006, XO Communications Services, Inc. ("XO") filed its complaint in this docket. Verizon Florida Inc. ("Verizon") filed a motion to dismiss that complaint on May 22, 2006. Staff has not yet issued its recommendation on Verizon's motion to dismiss.

On June 28, 2006, Verizon filed a petition for dispute resolution with XO over some of the same matters raised in XO's complaint in this docket. (Verizon's petition for dispute resolution was assigned Docket No. 060479-TP.) Verizon and XO have, therefore, agreed that XO's complaint docket should be held in abeyance at least until the parties notify the Commission that mediation efforts have been exhausted with regard to Verizon's dispute resolution petition. This is the most efficient approach because resolution of the parties' dispute in Docket No. 060479-TP may obviate the need to proceed with Docket No. 060365-TP.

The parties ask Staff to notify them if there are problems with holding Docket No. 060365-TP in abeyance until conclusion of mediation efforts on Verizon's dispute resolution petition.
