**NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST  
CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Progress Energy Florida, Inc., ("PEF" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of confidential portions of Exhibit JP-1R to the direct testimony of Javier Portuondo dated August 8, 2006.

Specifically, Schedule E12, page 2 of 2 of Exhibit JP-1R contains sensitive business information concerning power purchases, the disclosure of which could impair the efforts of the Company to negotiate contracts on favorable terms. If energy suppliers were allowed to compare the information at issue, they could discern sensitive pricing information which could lead to adverse effects for the Company in future contract negotiations.

Attached as Exhibit A is a confidential, highlighted copy of the above referenced document.

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(1), PEF will file its Request for Confidential Classification for such confidential information contained therein within twenty-one (21) days of filing this request.

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
