REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Four Points Utility Corporation ("Utility"), by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, requests that the Commission classify as confidential Confidential Exhibit "4" to the Utility's application for original certificates to operate a water and wastewater utility in Polk County, Florida (the "Application"). In support of its request, the Utility states:

- 1. The Utility filed its original Application on September 8, 2005 on Commission Form PSC/ECR 016-R. Part III (A) of the Application requires that the applicant provide a "statement regarding the financial and technical ability of the applicant to continue to provide service." Pursuant to that requirement, attached hereto is Confidential Exhibit "4" to the Application demonstrating that the Utility is financially qualified to provide water and wastewater services.
- Confidential Exhibit "4" contains the unaudited personal financial statement of 2.. the Utility's owner. The information contained in Confidential Exhibit "4" is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, and is exempt from Section 119,07(1), Florida Statutes, and Article I, Section 24(a) of the Florida Constitution because it is "proprietary confidential business information."
- Section 367.156(3), Florida Statutes defines "proprietary confidential business 3. information" as:

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- ... information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or a private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public.
- 4. The disclosure of the specified confidential financial information in Confidential Exhibit "4" could negatively effect other business ventures of Mr. Meadows -- the Utility's sole shareholder. This, in turn, could weaken the financial position of the Utility's owner to the detriment of the Utility and its ratepayers. The Commission has previously ruled that similar personal financial information was entitled to confidential classification because the release of the information could adversely impact the utility owner's other business ventures, weaken that owner's financial position, and thus indirectly harm the utility or its ratepayers. *See In re: Investigation into the level of water and sewer earnings of Hydratech Utilities, Inc., In Martin County*, 88 F.P.S.C. 10:380, Docket No. 861201, Order No. 20175 (October 17, 1988).
- 5. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(4)(b), Florida Administrative Code, the Utility affirms that the material identified as confidential in Confidential Exhibit "4" is intended to be and is treated by the Utility and Mr. Meadows as confidential.
- 6. Attached hereto in a sealed envelope is a copy of Confidential Exhibit "4" with the confidential information subject to this request highlighted in transparent ink. This information should be given confidential treatment by the Commission. There is only one copy of this Confidential Exhibit "4" which is attached to the original filing hereof. Also attached hereto are seven edited copies of Exhibit "4" on which the confidential material has been redacted. Because Confidential Exhibit "4" is confidential in its entirety, there is no basis for articulating a line-by-line justification for the confidential treatment of the information.

WHEREFORE, the Utility respectfully requests that the information contained in Confidential Exhibit "4" be classified as confidential and exempt from the Public Records Act, Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and Article I, Section 24(a) of the Florida Constitution. The Utility further requests, pursuant to Section 367.156(4), Florida Statues that the specified confidential information in Confidential Exhibit "4" be classified by the Commission as confidential for the maximum period of time allowed and the unredacted copy of the confidential exhibit be returned promptly to the Utility upon of closure of this docket.
