
It is our understanding that Latitude on the River is an E.A. Fish Associates development that will include approximately 450 condominium units with first residents expected in/about June 2007.

The developer has informed us that it has entered into an agreement with Capitol Infrastructure, now known as Connexion Technologies, that grants certain exclusive rights to Connexion relative to communications service to residents at the development. The developer has further informed us that BellSouth may not place facilities within the building to reach units and provide service to residents.

Pursuant to Section 364.025(6), Florida Statutes, we are writing to inform the Commission that BellSouth has been restricted from installing its communications facilities during the construction phase of the above property. Accordingly, BellSouth is relieved of its carrier of last resort obligation at the property and will not be providing service to residents at the property. If a resident inquires, BellSouth will inform the resident of the restriction of BellSouth service at the property.
