Pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 364.051, "Price regulation," and Section 364.164, "Competitive market enhancement," Verizon Florida Inc. ("Company") submits this filing to adjust certain rates for basic and non-basic services and certain rates for intrastate switched access services. Specifically, the Company is making a single tariff filing that incorporates rate changes associated with rate rebalancing, approved by the Commission on December 24, 2003 in Docket No. 030867-TL, and its annual price regulation filing.

redacted tariff CMP payer	The basic local exchange rate increases related to the rate rebalancing docket are based on units for both basic local exchange and switched access services that have been updated to the 12 months ending June 30, 2006. In order to remain revenue neutral, as required by statute, the rate decreases for switched access services have been adjusted accordingly.
CTR	The 2006 price regulation filing permits basic local exchange revenues to be increased
ECR	by 2.3065%, as determined by the increase in the Gross Domestic Product - Price
GCL L- STIM	Index (GDP-PI). The Company's proposal increases basic local revenues by 1.1737%. Rates for non-basic services can be increased by up to 20% per category. All five of the Company's non basic service categories are within the allowable increase. Units
