PETITION OF TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the company's conservation cost recovery true-up and the cost recovery factors proposed for use during the period January 2007 – December 2007. In support thereof, the company says:

Conservation Cost Recovery

- 1. During the period January 2005 December 2005, Tampa Electric incurred actual net conservation costs of \$15,583,726, plus a beginning true-up over-recovery of \$2,405,000, for a total of \$13,178,726. The amount collected through the Conservation Cost Recovery Clause was \$15,718,319. The true-up amount for January 2005 December 2005 was an over-recovery of \$2,614,594, including interest. (See Exhibit (HTB-1); Schedule CT-1 and CT-3, page 2 of 3).
- 2. During the period January 2006 December 2006, the company anticipates incurring expenses of \$14,489,195. For the period the total net true-up over-recovery is estimated to be \$982,393, including interest. (See Exhibit (HTB-2); Schedule C-3, page 5 of 6).
- 3. For the forthcoming cost recovery period, January 2007 December 2007, Tampa Electric projects its total incremental conservation costs to be \$14,294,475. Tampa Electric's total true-up and projected expenditures for the projection period are estimated to be \$13,312,082, including true-up estimates for January 2006 through December 2006. When the required true-up

and projected expenditures are appropriately spread over the projected KWH sales for interruptible customers and firm retail customers pursuant to Docket No. 930759-EG, Order No. PSC-93-1845-FOF-EG dated December 29, 1993, the required conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2007 – December 2007 are as follows: 0.061 cents per KWH for Interruptible, 0.073 cents per KWH for Residential, 0.071 cents per KWH for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service, 0.063 cents per KWH for General Service Demand - Secondary, 0.062 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby - Secondary, 0.056 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby - Primary, 0.055 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby - Primary, 0.055 cents per KWH for General Service Large Demand and Firm Standby - Subtransmission, and 0.026 cents per KWH for Lighting. (See Exhibit (HTB-2); Schedule C-1, page 1 of 2.)

4. For the forthcoming cost recovery period, January 2007 – December 2007, the Contracted Credit Value for the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 rate riders will be \$7.78 per KWH. (See Exhibit (HTB-2); page 44.)

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company requests the Commission's approval of the company's prior period conservation cost recovery true-up calculations and projected conservation cost recovery charges to be collected during the period January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.
