Aqua Utilities submitted its request for approval of a projected test year ended December 31, 2007 for its anticipated application for a rate increase on May 10, 2006. Chairman Edgar approved Aqua Utilities' request on May 23, 2006, setting October 10, 2006, as the deadline for Aqua Utilities to file its petition, MFRs, testimony and filing fees. Aqua Utilities is requesting the additional time to ensure, to the maximum extent possible, that its rate request filing, which includes 80 water and wastewater systems, is complete and meets the numerous Commission rules and statutes related to rate increase requests. If approved, the extension will not cause the approved projected test year ended December 31, 2007 to be unrepresentative of the current operations of the systems located among the 15 counties. The approved projected test year will remain a representative period to measure cost of service for the purpose of establishing new, prospective rates.


