NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Rule 25-22.080(3), Florida Administrative Code, that the Florida Public Service Commission has received the joint petition of Florida Municipal Power Agency, JEA, Reedy Creek Improvement District, and the City of Tallahassee (Participants) for a determination of need for a proposed electrical power plant in Taylor County. The Participants propose the construction of a new 765 megawatt (MW) (net) pulverized coal electric generating power plant, located on approximately 3,000 acres southeast of Perry. Once completed, the Taylor Energy Center (TEC) will have a summer net capacity of 754.1 MW, and a winter rating of 755.1 MW. The proposed service date for the TEC is May 2012. This matter has been assigned Commission Docket No. 060635-EU.


