RE: Docket No. 060486-TP - Notice of adoption of existing interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement between Embarq Florida, Inc. (f/k/a Sprint-Florida, Incorporated) and Comcast Phone of Florida, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone by Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC.

By letter received June 29, 2006, Embarq Florida, Inc. filed a notice of adoption of the existing interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement, entered into between Embarq Florida, Inc. (f/k/a Sprint-Florida, Incorporated)) and Comcast Phone of Florida, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone which was deemed approved in Docket No. 050116-TP. Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC. is adopting the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement approved by the Commission in its entirety pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on September 12, 2006. The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.b of the Administrative Procedures Manual in that it complies with Section 252(i) of the Act. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
