THIRD REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION GRANTED BY ORDER NO. PSC-03-0892-CFO-EI

NOW, BEFORE THE COMMISSION, through undersigned counsel, comes Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") and, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006 of the Florida Administrative Code and Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, hereby submits its Third Request for Extension of Confidential Classification Granted by Order No PSC-03-0892-CFO-EI of the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC" or "Commission"), issued in Docket No. 011403-EI in connection with certain materials obtained pursuant to Audit Control No. 01-073-4-1 (Audit Control No. 01-073-4-1) (the "Audit"). In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

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- 2. On May 30, 2003, FPL filed with the Commission its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification of certain materials obtained during the Audit ("First Request"). FPL's initial filing consists of the Request for Confidential Classification and Exhibits A through D.
- 3. On May 30, 2003, FPL filed its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification Granted by Order No. PSC-01-2339-CFO-EI of Certain Material Obtained Pursuant to Audit Control No. 01-073-4-1. By Order No. PSC-03-0892-CFO-EI, issued August 4, 2003, the extension was granted.
- 4. On February 3, 2005, FPL filed its Second Request for Extension of Confidential Classification Granted by Order No. PSC-03-0892-CFO-EI. By Order No. PSC-05-0332-CFO-EI, issued March 23, 2005, the extension was granted.
 - 5. The period of confidential treatment granted by the Commission will soon expire.
- 6. Some of the information that was the subject of FPL's October 29, 2001, Request and FPL's First and Second Requests for Extension warrants continued treatment as proprietary and confidential business information with the meaning of Section 366.093. Accordingly, FPL hereby submits its Third Request for Extension of Confidential Classification.
- 7. FPL incorporates herein by reference Exhibits A and B from its October 29, 2001 filing.
- 8. FPL incorporates herein by reference Exhibit C, List of Confidential Workpapers, which was initially filed October 29, 2001 and revised and replaced within FPL's Second Request for Extension of Confidential Classification filed on February 3, 2005.

- 9. Also included herewith and made a part hereof is Exhibit D. Exhibit D consists of the Affidavit of Robert Onsgard which Affidavit shall replace Exhibit D previously filed October 29, 2001, May 30, 2003 and February 3, 2005.
- 10. FPL submits that such information is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3). Pursuant to Section 366.093, such materials are entitled to confidential treatment and are exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- document or portion thereof are set forth in the Justification Table under the column titled "FLORIDA STATUTE 366.093(3)." The letters (a) through (e) refer to subsections of Section 366.093(3), as applicable. Support for FPL's Third Request for Extension of Confidential Classification of the referenced material is provided through the affidavit of Robert Onsgard. The Justification Table identifies the affiant attesting to the basis for FPL's assertion of confidentiality with regard to each document or portion thereof. The materials at issue contain or constitute internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors or information relating to the same. Nothing has changed since the issuance of Order No. PSC-05-0332-CFO-EI to render the information stale or public such that continued confidential treatment would not be appropriate.
- 12. As reflected by the renewed affidavit submitted as Exhibit D, nothing has changed since the issuance of Order No. PSC 03-0892-CFO-EI to render the information stale or public such that continued confidential treatment would not be appropriate. Accordingly, FPL

requests that the information be accorded confidential classification for an additional eighteenmonth period. FPL further requests that the information be returned to FPL as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and affidavit included herewith and incorporated herein by reference, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Third Request for Extension of Confidential Classification be granted.
