2. What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2007 through December 2007?

- 3. What should be the effective date of the conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?
- <u>Florida City Gas</u>: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2007 through December 2007. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2007, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2007, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.

Florida City Gas is not a party to any stipulations at this time, although it believes that it should be possible to reach a stipulation on each of the above issues as they relate to Florida City Gas.
