Alltel Communications, Inc. (Alltel), by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification, and states as follows:

- 1. Contemporaneous with the filing of this request, Alltel has provided responses to Staff data requests in this proceeding.
- 2. Response to Staff Data Request 36 contains proprietary confidential business information of Alltel. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code, Alltel files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification of the proprietary confidential business information in the response.
- 3. Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, provides an exemption from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes, for "proprietary confidential business information." Under Section 364.180(3)(e), Florida Statutes, "proprietary confidential business information" includes "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information. In this case, the information provided by Alltel contains sufficient information such that its competitors would be able to determine the number of Alltel wireless customers per wire center.
- 4. The information described above and provided in Response to Staff Data Request 36 is competitively sensitive information of Alltel and the public disclosure of such information would impair the competitive business of Alltel and provide a competitive advantage to competitors in the telecommunications service market. Alltel maintains this information as proprietary confidential business information which, if publicly disclosed, could be used by competitors to harm Alltel's competitive interests. The information for which confidential classification is sought is intended to be and treated as private and confidential by Alltel, and has not been disclosed publicly or otherwise. Accordingly, the information should be determined to be proprietary confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes, exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

5. Attached as Attachment A are two copies of the redacted versions of Alltel's proprietary confidential business information included in Response to Staff Data Request 36.

6. Attached and included in a sealed envelope marked as Attachment B to this Request for Specified Confidential Classification are highlighted copies of the same documents containing the confidential information.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Alltel Communications, Inc. respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission enter an Order declaring the information described above to be proprietary confidential business information that is not subject to public disclosure.

Data Request No. 2:

In the last twelve (12) months, have any complaints been filed with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regarding Alltel's service in Florida? If so, how many?

Response:

Yes. During the 12 month period between September 1, 2005 and August 30, 2006, a total of ninety-two (92) complaints were filed with the FCC regarding Alltel's service in Florida.

Data Request No. 3:

Pursuant to Order No. PSC98-0328-FOF-TP, issued February 24, 1998, all ETCs in Florida must contribute \$3.50 per month per Lifeline customer, for a total credit of \$13.50 to each Lifeline customer. If granted ETC status, will Alltel comply with this order by providing the appropriate contribution(s)?

Response:

Yes. Alltel will comply with the requirements of Order No. PSC-98-0328-FOF-TP, with respect to requiring all ETCs designated by the state Commission providing a Lifeline credit of at least \$13.50 to each Lifeline customer.

Data Request No. 4:

List the companies which Alltel has Interconnection Agreements with in the state of Florida. What type of services do the agreements cover (Resale, Lease of Network Elements, etc.)?

Response:

Alltel has a total of thirteen (13) Interconnection Agreements with other carriers in the state of Florida. Please see below for details:

Data Request No. 5:

What facilities, planned or existing, does Alltel have in Florida in order to serve potential Florida customers?

Response:

Alltel's current network in the state of Florida consists of 757 digital CDMA cell sites and 8 switches located in Ft Myers, Gainesville, Jacksonville, Panama City, Pensacola, Pinellas, Tallahassee and Tampa. As evidenced in the five-year build-out plan, submitted to the FCC in anticipation of ETC designation, Alltel planned to build an additional 24 cell sites and expend in excess of \$26M to upgrade its existing facilities in 2006 in the state of Florida. The five-year build-out plan submitted under seal with the Applications detail Alltel's plans for 2007.

Data Request No. 6:

Explain how Alltel identifies the location of its mobile wireless customers for universal service purposes?

Response:

Consistent with FCC Rules and Orders Alltel identifies the location of its mobile customers for federal universal service purposes based on the customer's billing address.

Data Request No. 7:

In its petition, Alltel indicates that it intends to offer most of its services using its own facilities. It also mentions that it may occasionally provide services through the resale of another carrier's service in areas lacking adequate coverage. How many "facilities based" customers and how many resale customers does Alltel have in the requested territories?

Response:

At the end of the Second Quarter of 2006 Alltel had approx. 472,897 facilities based customers in the requested territories in the state of Florida. Alltel did not provide service on a resold basis to any customers during this period.

Data Request No. 8:

What is the average monthly customer's bill for an Alltel customer in Florida?

Response:

The average monthly bill for an Alltel Florida customer as of 9/30/2006 was approx. \$53. This includes monthly charges, toll charges, data services and other services provided by Alltel.

Data Request No. 9:

What is the average Lifeline customer monthly bill in Florida?

Response:

Alltel offers stand-alone Lifeline rate plans pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 54.403(a). The standard Lifeline plan is available to qualifying customers for \$16.70 per month. The Lifeline Tribal plan is available to qualifying customers for \$1 per month. Additional airtime is available for \$0.45 per minute. Toll is available for \$0.40 per minute and roaming outside the Alltel home coverage area is \$0.59 per minute. The average Lifeline customers' bill can vary from month to month depending on the subscribers' unique usage patterns.

Data Request No. 10:

Does an Alltel customer have to sign a service agreement? If so, for what term? What are the terms and conditions? Is an Alltel Lifeline customer required to sign a contract or any similar agreements? Please provide an example of the standard agreement.

Response:

An Alltel customer is not required to sign a fixed term service contract unless the customer chooses to purchase the handset at a discounted price. A customer that chooses to purchase the handset at a discounted price has the option of selecting a one or two year term contract. A customer that signs a fixed term contract and chooses to terminate service before the expiration of that contract will be subject to an early cancellation fee that is disclosed to the customer at the point of sale.

An Alltel Lifeline customer is not required to sign a fixed term service contract even if the customer purchases a handset at a discounted price. Alltel Lifeline offerings are pre-paid services, which do not impose contractual obligations.

¹ A customer that purchases a handset at full price is eligible for the same rates and services available to customers that purchase a handset at a discounted price.

Data Request No. 11:

Does Alltel's Lifeline and Link-Up program include a free phone?

Response:

No. A qualifying Lifeline customer, that does not already possess an E911 Phase II compatible handset capable of operating on Alltel's CDMA network, is required to purchase a handset for \$19.99. A qualifying customer that already has an E911 Phase II compatible handset is not required to purchase a handset.

Data Request No. 12:

Does Alltel require a security deposit for any of its Florida Lifeline customers? If yes, under what conditions and how much is the deposit?

Response:

No. Alltel does not charge security deposits on any of the Company's pre-paid plans, including the Lifeline pre-paid plans.²

² FCC rule 47 C.F.R. § 54.401(c) states that Eligible telecommunications carriers may not collect a service deposit in order to initiate Lifeline service, if the qualifying low- income consumer voluntarily elects toll limitation service from the carrier, where available. If toll limitation services are unavailable, the carrier may charge a service deposit

Data Request No. 13:

Will Alltel's activation fee be waived for Lifeline/Link-Up customers as part of the Link-Up program?

Response:

Yes. Alltel waives the \$35 activation fee for qualifying Lifeline subscribers in its current ETC areas. Alltel will waive the \$35 activation fee in the rural telephone company service areas identified in its Applications upon ETC designation.

Data Request No. 14:

If Alltel receives ETC designation for rural areas in Florida, approximately how long will it take for Alltel to offer Lifeline service in those areas? Please elaborate on any extenuating or special circumstances.

Response:

Alltel can begin offering Lifeline services within 30-days of designation. Alltel can make the necessary systems changes within 30-days to expand the Lifeline processes that are currently in place in the non-rural areas.

Data Request No. 15:

In Exhibit C of both petitions, Alltel displays several rate plans and indicates that these rate plans equal or surpass similar plans offered by the incumbent LECs. Will all these plans be available to potential customers in the designated areas, including Lifeline and Link-Up customers? If not, please explain.

Response:

All rate plans are available to potential non-Lifeline customers. As described in the Response to Data Request #9 above, Alltel offers stand-alone Lifeline and Tribal Lifeline rate plans.³ However, Alltel is considering expanding its Lifeline offerings at this time.

³ FCC Rule 47 C.F.R. § 54.403 (b) states that Eligible telecommunications carriers that charge federal End User Common Line charges or equivalent federal charges shall apply Tier-One federal Lifeline support to waive the federal End-User Common Line charges for Lifeline consumers. Such carriers shall apply any additional federal support amount to a qualifying low-income consumer's intrastate rate, if the carrier has received the non-federal regulatory approvals necessary to implement the required rate reduction. Other eligible telecommunications carriers shall apply the Tier-One federal Lifeline support amount, plus any additional support amount, to reduce their lowest tariffed (or otherwise generally available) residential rate for the services enumerated in Sec. 54.101(a)(1) through (a)(9), and charge Lifeline consumers the resulting amount.

Data Request No. 16:

Describe Alltel's toll-limitation features. See 47 C.F.R. 54.101(a)(9).

Response:

Alltel provides toll blocking to its Lifeline customers. Alltel uses a customer's mobile number to block the customer ability to make calls outside the local calling area.

Data Request No. 17:

According to 47 C.F.R. 54.101(c):

A state Commission may grant the petition of a telecommunications carrier that is otherwise eligible to receive universal service support under Section 54.201, if the party is requesting additional time to complete the network upgrades needed to provide single party service, access to enhanced 911, or toll limitation. If such petition is granted, the otherwise eligible telecommunications carrier will be permitted to receive universal service support for the duration of the period designated by the state commission.

If you will be making such a request, what time frame will be necessary for Alltel to accomplish these network upgrades? Please include in your response all areas for which you are seeking ETC designation.

Response:

As demonstrated in its Application, Alltel either currently provides or is capable of providing the nine supported services identified in 47 C.F.R. 54.101(a) upon being designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier throughout the areas identified in its Applications. The FCC has already found that Alltel satisfies this requirement in the non-rural areas.

Data Request No. 18:

Does Alltel understand that there may be an audit of the use of universal service funds and that the eligible telecommunications service designation is reviewed annually by state commissions?

Response:

Yes. Alltel understands that state commissions must annually certify, to both the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) and the FCC, that eligible telecommunications carriers subject to its jurisdiction will utilize high-cost support only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended. Alltel has committed to meet the annual reporting requirements identified in 47 C.F.R. 54.209 to assist the Commission with its annual review.

Data Request No. 19:

Is Alltel aware that Florida Lifeline customers who no longer qualify for Lifeline are allowed to receive a discounted rate at 70 percent of the residential basic rate for a period of one year? Will Alltel abide by this directive?

Response:

Alltel is aware of such Florida Lifeline requirement and, once designated as an ETC by the Florida Public Service Commission, will abide by the requirement.

Data Request No. 20:

What is the status of the sale of Alltel's wireline affiliated company and VALOR? Is Alltel solely a wireless company with no contractual tying agreements/arrangements with Windstream, VALOR or its subsidiaries? If separate arrangements exist, please provide a summary of the subject arrangement(s).

Response:

The separation of Alltel's wireline business from Alltel and merger of the wireline business into Valor (now Windstream) was completed on July 17, 2006. Alltel is now a wireless company. Alltel and Windstream entered into certain transition and continued service agreements effective with the July 17, 2006 closing.

Data Request No. 21:

Is Alltel seeking ETC designation in any areas that area considered part of tribal lands? If yes, please describe each area and indicate whether a copy of its petition was sent to the affected tribal government?

Response:

Although the Brighton, Big Cypress and Miccosukee Reservations are within Sprint Florida Inc.'s territory, Alltel is not requesting that it be designated as an ETC in any of the wire centers within those reservations.

Data Request No. 22:

Does Alltel agree to abide by all Florida Statutes, Rules and Commission Orders regarding ETCs?

Response:

Alltel will abide by all current Florida Statutes, Rules and Commission Orders applicable to ETCs that receive federal universal service support.

Data Request No. 23:

How many customers does Alltel have in the State of Florida?

Response:

Alltel had approx. 989,000 customers in the state of Florida as of June 30, 2006.

Data Request No. 24:

By Order No. DA 04-3046, released September 24, 2004, the FCC granted eligible telecommunications carrier ETC status to Alltel Communications, Inc. in non-rural wire centers of Verizon and Bell South in Florida. Since that time, Alltel has received \$10,293,491 (through July 2006) in universal service funds from Florida. The Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) shows no reimbursement to Alltel for providing Lifeline service during that time. Alltel has claimed that it doesn't seek reimbursement for Lifeline service from USAC.

a. Provide the number of Florida Lifeline customers enrolled by Alltel since becoming an ETC in Florida in 2004.

Response:

Alltel has not retained historical lifeline data as it has not sought low-income subsidies from the federal USF. Therefore, Alltel does not have the data to respond to this question.

b. Provide the current number of Alltel Lifeline customers in Florida.

Response:

As of 9/30/2006 Alltel had 31 customers enrolled for its Lifeline service in the state of Florida.

c. Describe Alltel's annual verification process used for Lifeline customers.

Response:

The FCC requires ETCs to annually verify the continued eligibility of a statistically valid sample of their Lifeline subscribers. Lifeline subscribers who are subject to this verification and qualify for Lifeline service under the incomebased eligibility criteria must prove their continued eligibility by presenting current documentation consistent with the federal default certification process, as detailed above. These subscribers must also self-certify within 60 days of receiving the notification, and under penalty of perjury, the number of individuals in their household and that the documentation presented accurately represents their annual household income.

Data Request No. 25:

Referring to page 2 of each Application, please provide a detailed description of the rates and conditions of the "basic universal service package" that will be offered to Lifeline/Link up customers.

If you have never used the Services before and do not wish to be bound by these Terms and Conditions, do not begin using the Services or Equipment and notify us immediately.

Term

- a. Fixed Term. You agree to subscribe to the Services for the length of time identified on the Service Order. The Services you receive after the end of the term will be provided on a month-to-month basis and remain at all times subject to the Terms and Conditions.
- b. Month-to-Month Term. If no length of time is identified on the Service Order, then the term is month-to-month.

Termination By You

- a. Fixed Term. If you subscribe to a Service for a fixed term and you terminate that Service before the expiration of the fixed term then you will be required to pay us an early cancellation fee as specified on your Service Order. If there is no early cancellation fee specified on your Service Order, then you will be required to pay \$200 per line for any early cancellation. In addition, you remain liable for payment of all outstanding charges for all Services you used and Equipment you purchased from us prior to termination.
- b. Month-to-Month Term. You may terminate a Service to which you subscribe on a month-to-month basis at any time by notifying us. You remain liable for payment of all outstanding charges for all Services you used and Equipment you purchased from us prior to termination.
- c. Change in Location. A change in your service address or the location to which any Service is provided to you may constitute, at our sole discretion, termination of the Services or an increase in the prices you must pay for the Services.

d. Number Portability. A request by you to port your number will be deemed a request by you to terminate your Agreement.

Termination By Us

We may limit, interrupt, terminate or refuse to provide a Service for the following reasons, or for any other good cause: (a) if you do not honor any provision of these Terms and Conditions (including payment obligations), (b) if you use a Service in a manner that adversely affects Service to other customers or harasses our customers, our employees, or others, (c) if you or others use a Service to engage in fraud or unlawful conduct or are suspected of doing so, (d) if you modify your wireless phone or any software residing thereon from the original manufacturer specifications, including for the purpose of accessing non-Alltel services, (e) if your Service is used in a manner that is excessive or unreasonable with respect to volume or length of calls when compared to the predominant volume or length of call of other customers on a similar rate plan or in your geographic area, or (f) if the majority of your Service is used roaming on a network not owned or operated by Alltel. You may not resell any Service. We may restore such interrupted or terminated Service, in our sole discretion, following your correction of the violation and payment of any amounts due, including any restoration charge we assess for restoring your Service.

Charges for Services and Equipment

- a. In General. You are responsible for paying all charges applicable to your Equipment and Service, including: access charges, airtime, features, text messaging, roaming, toll, long distance, and directory assistance. In addition, you are responsible for paying any taxes, surcharges, fees, and assessments imposed by us or a governmental authority from time to time in connection with the Services or the Equipment.
- Wireless Airtime Charges. Airtime usage on each call is billed in full minute increments, with b. a minimum charge of one minute per call. Partial minutes of use are rounded up to the next full minute. Access charges are billed in advance and will not be deducted from your bill or refunded in the event of termination. Unused plan minutes are not carried over to subsequent monthly billing cycles. In some instances, information regarding airtime usage, including roaming or long distance charges, is not available to be included in the bill for the month that the Service is used, and will be billed to you in a subsequent bill. The Service will be charged, and deducted from your plan minutes, in the month it is billed. The length of a call will be measured from when you initiate it (typically, when you press the "Send" key) until you terminate it (typically, when you press the "End" key). You may incur additional charges for roaming or long distance calls. Rates and charges while roaming outside of your local Alltel service area may be different from your Alltel service area rates. We reserve the right to select the carrier you will use while roaming. Rates during peak hours may be higher than rates during off-peak hours. Use of custom calling features (such as voicemail or three-way calling) will be billed like any other call. To be eligible for Service, we may require you to reside in our Service area and to use most of your Service on a network owned or operated by Alltel.
- c. Wireless Data Charges. Wireless data services may be billed in full kilobyte increments. Partial kilobyte increments of use may be rounded to the next full kilobyte. Unused kilobytes may not be carried over to subsequent monthly billing cycles. Access time may be measured from the time the port is seized to the time the port is released by your Equipment.

Billing Information Provided By You

To determine whether certain taxes, fees and surcharges are applicable to Service provided to you, we are required by federal law to obtain your street address, which must be within our service area. You represent and warrant that the address you provide us to obtain Service is correct, and you acknowledge that we are relying on this information to determine which taxes, fees or surcharges are applicable to your Service. You agree to notify us if your address changes. In the event you do not provide us with a valid address or address change, you understand and agree that you may be responsible for additional taxes, fees or surcharges for your Service, and we may terminate your Service.

Payments

We will bill you monthly for all charges associated with the Services, and we will invoice you for all charges associated with Equipment. Payment in full is due no later than the due date indicated on your bill. If you have authorized payment for Services or Equipment by credit card or by debiting a bank account, no additional notice or consent is required before we invoice the credit card or debit the bank account for all amounts due to us for any reason. We may accept late payments, partial payments or any payments marked

as being "payment in full" or as being settlement of any dispute without losing any of our rights under this Agreement. You agree to pay costs and fees we incur to collect an unpaid balance from you.

Credits And Deposits

You authorize us to ask credit-reporting agencies for credit information about you. We may, in our discretion, require you to submit a deposit as security for payment of charges. An additional deposit may be required if either the amount or number of Services is increased or your credit rating changes. Simple interest will be paid on the cash deposit for the period it is held by us and will be refunded if satisfactory credit has been established or upon termination of service. We reserve the right to apply the deposit to any amount due and unpaid. We may require a guarantee of payment by an individual or entity approved by us.

Personal Identifiers

We assign telephone numbers, e-mail addresses and other personal identifiers in connection with the Services. Unless we provide you advance notice, you have no proprietary right to any such identifiers, and we reserve the right to change them upon notice to you. In the event that you become entitled to transfer a personal identifier to another party to obtain any Services we provide you, we reserve the right, prior to honoring the request for transfer, to charge a fee for the transfer and to collect any money owed by you for Services or Equipment.

Services Provided by Third Parties

The Services will be provided either by us or by our third party vendors or contractors. We reserve the right to change or modify the source of any Services provided to you without notice.

Unauthorized Use of Third Party Services

You agree that the mobile phone on which your Alltel Service is activated may not be used to access any third-party services equivalent to Services provided, or Services made available, by Alltel even if you declined to purchase such Services from Alltel. Your mobile phone contains programming designed to enable access to Alltel Services only. Using any manual or electronic means to circumvent any restrictions placed on your mobile phone or to modify without authorization any programming supplied on your phone is a violation of your Agreement.

Privacy and Customer Proprietary Network Information

You authorize us to monitor and record communications to us regarding your account or the Services for purposes of quality assurance. We will not give you notice of any subpoenas or court orders related to your account or use of Services unless required by law. Information in our billing and customer care systems concerning your account and your use of Services belongs to us, and you have no expectation of privacy with respect to such information. You agree that we may release information we have about you when required to do so by law, to provide to third parties solely for the purpose of assisting us in providing any Service to you, or if we reasonably believe that an emergency involving immediate harm to a person or property requires disclosure. We may analyze your account and usage information and share this information with other Alltel entities to communicate with you regarding Equipment or Services that may become available to you. If you do not want us to provide your information to other Alltel entities for this purpose, please notify us.

Theft and Fraud

If your Service or Equipment is lost or stolen or fraudulently used, then you are responsible for all usage incurred before we receive notice from you of such loss or theft. You agree to cooperate in the investigation of fraud or theft and to provide us with such information and documentation as we may request (including affidavits and police reports).

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

IN THE EVENT WE ARE FOUND TO BE RESPONSIBLE TO YOU FOR DAMAGES IN ANY WAY RELATING TO THE SERVICES OR EQUIPMENT, YOU AGREE THAT OUR LIABILITY TO YOU WILL NOT EXCEED YOUR PRO-RATED MONTHLY RECURRING CHARGE FOR SERVICES DURING THE PERIOD IN WHICH YOU INCUR SUCH DAMAGES. WE ARE NOT LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES (SUCH AS LOST PROFITS OR LOST BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES), PUNITIVE OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES, THE COST OF ALTERNATIVE SERVICES, OR ATTORNEYS' FEES.

DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES

WE MAKE NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES REGARDING THE SERVICES OR EQUIPMENT YOU RECEIVE FROM US, AND DISCLAIM ANY WARRANTIES OR REPRESENTATIONS, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. WE ARE NOT

RESPONSIBLE FOR CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR CONTROL, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF OTHERS, ATMOSPHERIC CONDITIONS, OR ACTS OF GOD. WE DO NOT PROMISE UNINTERRUPTED OR ERROR FREE SERVICE. In areas for which the company is seeking ETC designation, how many back up generators are in operation?

Response:

Alltel has a total of 138 back up generators in operation in the areas that it is seeking ETC designation.

There are no restrictions on individual plans other than the fact that the change may not become effective until the next billing cycle. This service may not be available to larger business accounts that receive volume discounts.

Data Request No. 33:

Referring to page 12 of each Application, Equal Access, is Alltel currently technically capable of providing equal access? If not, what network modifications would be required and approximately how long would it take to make such modification?

Response:

While it may be "technically" possible to provide Equal Access ⁴ it would be an extensive and expensive undertaking to actually implement Equal Access. Equal Access was mandated to facilitate competition in the intraLATA toll market at a time when such competition did not exist and when the only means of accessing a toll provider was by the landline provider. The traditional telephone market has changed dramatically since 1996. Mobile service providers such as Alltel bundle local, LD, and airtime usage into attractive service offerings. As a result, interest in "Equal Access" has diminished significantly. Even without equal access, a customer can access a long distance provider of his/her choice because the customer has the ability to dial-around.

"Partially served" means Alltel is not licensed to served the Rural LEC study area in its entirety. In this instance the, Florida Commission may redefine the Rural LEC's service area in accordance with FCC rule 54.207(c)(1) to include only those areas that are within Alltel's licensed service area.

Response:

The FCC, in paragraph 44 of its March 17, 2005 Universal Service Order, indicates that it will consider "consumer choice" and the "advantages and disadvantages of a particular offering" when determining the public interest. In a competitive market customers not only have more choices but competitive rates. The FCC has recognized that universal service can help bring more choices and competitive rates that are available in the urban areas to the rural areas of the United States.

b. Please explain what a "competitive universal service offering" is and why it is appropriate to encourage such multiple offerings.

Response:

A "universal service offering" must consist of the nine-supported service identified in 47 C.F.R. 54.101(a). However, when these services are provided using different technologies customers are afforded distinct choices. Customers are therefore, able to choose a service provider and a service offering that best meet their communication needs. Clearly, the most attractive features of a wireless competitive universal service offering are the benefits associated with mobility and freedom to make calls within a larger calling area without incurring additional expenses.
