

STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL CAPABILITY

Applicant has sufficient financial capability to provide the requested service in the State of Florida and has sufficient financial capability to maintain the requested service and to meet its lease or ownership obligations. In support of Applicant's stated financial capability, a copy of its Income Statement For the period ending September 30, 2006 and Balance Sheet as of September 30, 2006 is attached to its application. Applicant intends to fund the provision of service through internally generated cash flow. Applicant also has the ability to borrow funds, if required, based upon its financial capabilities, to provide service in the State of Florida.

EXPLANATION OF REVOCATION

Infotelecom, LLC's CLEC Certificate No. 8566 was cancelled for violation of Section 364.183(1), F.S., Access to Company Records, in Docket No. 050964-TX.

The Company has entered into an agreement with an outside regulatory compliance company to handle ongoing compliance matters.

All reports should be filed timely in the future. In addition, the company intends to comply with all Commission rules and regulations, and believes that it would be in the public interest to allow it to obtain CLEC authority in the State of Florida.

The company has yet to provide any local or long distance service in the State of Florida.

Pursuant to previous discussions with Staff, the Applicant is willing to offer a payment in the amount of \$3,500 to the Commission in settlement of the penalty imposed in the above-referenced Docket.
