Legent Communications Corporation d/b/a Long Distance America ("Legent"), by its undersigned attorneys, hereby responds to the Florida Public Service Commission's letter dated October 23, 2006 ("letter"), regarding Order No. PSC-03-1469-FOF-TL ("Order").

Legent is a provider of interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Florida, pursuant to Order No. PSC-02-0515-PAA-TI, issued April 16, 2002, in Docket No. 020107-TI.

Legent attests that its intrastate switched access expense reduction under the Order is less than \$100. Therefore, pursuant to the letter, Legent is not obligated to flow through the reduction in its intrastate switched access expense to its retail rates. As permitted by the letter, this attestation covers Incumbent Local Exchange Companies ("ILECs") Verizon, Embarq (formerly Sprint) and BellSouth.

Very few of Legent's customers actually use its services to complete intrastate interexchange calls in Florida. Legent does not directly pay intrastate access charges to any ILECs. Instead, Legent purchases termination minutes from wholesale providers. Legent assumes that intrastate access charges are incorporated into the rates charged by Legent's underlying carriers. However, Legent is not directly invoiced for such charges.
