BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On September 11, 2006, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff") requested copies of each contract signed by the developer with the accompanying COLR letter used by BellSouth along with all correspondence between BellSouth and each developer that received a COLR letter.
