To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in regards to docket #060481-WU. We, the undersigned, have a concern with the Lance Water System owned by Jeffrey Hill of Lake City, Florida. We believe that the system should not be considered a small water system. It should be regulated to protect the quality of drinking water and the price that is being charged to our subdivision. There is an understanding that the prices we are charged are not the same prices that are charged to everyone on this water system. The price has already increased in the last couple months so there is concern as to how many more times Mr. Hill will increase his price.

I received an e-mail from Mr. Redemann on July 12th about the hearing scheduled for July 18th. Due to this short notice we are unable to make the trip to Tallahassee for this hearing. We sincerely hope this letter will let you know that we are concerned and would like to be heard in this matter. If Mr. Hill's system is not regulated, what will protect us from price gouging? We have already been told by Mr. Hill that in order to have water we have to use his system and are not allowed to install our own well. We understand that Mr. Hill already has to pay arrearages for failing to comply with notices sent to him by your department. We do not want to be punished by him increasing our prices because of his non cooperation if he does not become regulated. The homes in this subdivision are occupied by single persons, single parents with low income and small families who cannot afford to be charged according to what Mr. Hill thinks is fair. We also feel we have the right to take measures to insure the water we are using is safe and affordably fair. We should not have to worry that by doing this Mr. Hill will increase prices in retaliation. Hopefully this letter will help you in your decision. We appreciate the work that has been done on this case so far and look forward to hearing the outcome.
