

SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

<u>Authorization Code</u> — A predefined series of numbers to be dialed by the Customer upon access to the Company's system to identify the caller and validate the caller's authorization to use the Service. Automatic number identification (ANI) is used as the authorization code wherever possible.

<u>Commission</u> — Used throughout this tariff to mean the Florida Public Service Commission.

<u>Customer</u> — The person, firm, corporation or other legal entity which purchases a Prepaid Calling Card and/or originates prepaid calls using such cards, and is responsible for the payment of charges and for compliance with the Company's tariff regulations.

Company — Used throughout this tariff to mean Verizon International (T)
Communications Services Inc., a Delaware corporation. (T)

<u>Prepaid Account</u> — An inventory of Telecom Units purchased in advance by the Customer, and associated with one and only one Authorization Code as contained in a specific Prepaid Calling Card.

<u>Prepaid Calling Card</u> — A card issued by the Company, containing an Authorization Code which identifies a specific Prepaid Account of Telecom Units, which enables calls to be processed, account activity to be logged, and balances to be maintained, on a prepayment basis.

<u>Telecom Unit</u> — A measurement of telecommunications service equivalent to one minute of usage between any two points within the State of Florida.

<u>Telecommunications</u> — The transmission of voice communications or, subject to the transmission capabilities of the services, the transmission of data, facsimile, signaling, metering, or other similar communications.

<u>Underlying Carrier</u> — The telecommunications carrier whose network facilities provide the technical capability and capacity necessary for the transmission and reception of Customer telecommunications traffic.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

2.1 Undertaking of the Company

This tariff contains the regulations and rates applicable to the provision of Prepaid Calling Card Service between points within the State of Florida. The Service is furnished subject to the availability of facilities and subject to the terms and conditions of this tariff in compliance with limitations set forth in the Commission's regulations. The Service is provided on a statewide basis and is not intended to be limited geographically. The Company offers the Service to all persons, firms, corporations or other legal entities who desire to purchase the Service from the Company consistent with all of the provisions of this tariff.

2.1.1 The services provided by the Company are not part of a joint undertaking with any other entity providing telecommunications channels, facilities, or services, but may involve the resale of the Message Toll Services (MTS) and Wide Area Telecommunications Services (WATS) of underlying common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

- 2.3.5 The Company's liability, resulting in whole or in part from or arising in connection with furnishing the Service under this tariff. including but not limited to loss of revenue or profits, for any reason whatsoever, including the breakdown of facilities associated with the Service, or mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors, or other defects in transmission occurring during the course of furnishing the Service, shall not exceed an amount equal to the number of Telecom Units expended for the call for the period during which the call was affected and will not include any indirect, special, incidental, consequential, exemplary, or punitive losses or damages under this tariff. Neither the Company, nor its employees, agents, contractors, distributors, or any cooperating service provider(s) shall be liable or responsible for theft, loss or unauthorized use of any Prepaid Calling Cards or card numbers. No other liability in any event shall attach to the Company, except as ordered by the Commission.
- 2.3.6 The Company, its officers, directors, employees, shareholders, distributors, and their respective heirs and assigns, are specifically excused and indemnified, saved and held harmless, by each Customer taking Service under this tariff for any claim of misrepresentation, or errors or omissions made by sales representatives or sales agents.
- 2.3.7 No agent or employee of any other carrier, distributor, or entity, including the Underlying Carrier, shall be deemed to be an agent or employee of the Company.

2.4 Responsibilities of the Customer

- 2.4.1 The Customer is responsible for complying with tariff regulations. The Customer must use the Service offered in this tariff in a manner consistent with the terms of this tariff and the policies and regulations of all state, federal and local authorities having jurisdiction over the Service.
- 2.4.2 The Customer shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Company against:
 - 2.4.2.A Claims for libel, slander, invasion, infringement of copyright or patent, unauthorized use of any trademark, trade name or service mark, arising out of the material, data, information or other content revealed to, transmitted by or used by the Company under this tariff.
 - 2.4.2.B All other claims including, but without limitation, damage to a business or property, or injury to, or death of, any person arising out of any act or omission of the Customer, or the Customer's agents, in connection with the Service provided under this tariff.

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2.5 Cancellation or Interruption of Services

- 2.5.1 Without incurring liability, the Company may discontinue Service to a Customer by suspending the Customer's Prepaid Calling Card:
 - 2.5.1.A For violation of any provision of this tariff;
 - 2.5.1.B For violation of any law, rule, regulation, policy of any governing authority having jurisdiction over the Company's Service;
 - 2.5.1.C By reason of any order or decision of a court, public service commission or federal regulatory body or other governing authority prohibiting the Company from furnishing its Service; or
 - 2.5.1.D For fraudulent use of a Prepaid Calling Card.
- 2.5.2 Calls in progress will be terminated by the Company if the balance on the Prepaid Calling Card is insufficient to continue the call.
- 2.5.3 Without incurring liability, the Company may interrupt the provision of services at any time in order to perform tests and inspections to assure compliance with tariff regulations and the proper installation and operation of Customer and the Company's equipment and facilities and may continue such interruption until any items of noncompliance or improper equipment operation so identified are rectified.
- 2.5.4 Service may be discontinued by the Company without notice to the Customer, by blocking traffic to certain counties, cities or NXX exchanges, or by blocking calls using certain Customer authorization codes, when the Company deems it necessary to take such action to prevent unlawful use of its service. The Company will restore service as soon as it can be provided without undue risk, and will, upon request by the Customer affected, assign a new authorization code to replace the one that has been deactivated.

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2.6 Credit Allowance - Interruption of Service

- 2.6.1 A credit allowance for the Service is applicable to calls that are interrupted due to poor transmission, one-way transmission, or involuntary disconnection of a call. To receive the proper credit, the Customer must notify the Company within seven (7) calendar days at the designated toll-free customer service number printed on the Prepaid Calling Card and furnish the toll-free or local access number to use the card, a description of the trouble experienced (e.g. cut-off, noisy circuit, etc.), and the approximate time that the call was placed.
- 2.6.2 When a call charged to a Prepaid Calling Card is interrupted due to cut-off, one-way transmission, or poor transmission conditions, the Customer will receive a credit equivalent of one Telecom Unit.
- 2.6.3 Credit allowances for calls pursuant to the Service do not apply to interruptions not reported within seven calendar days to the Company or interruptions that are due to the failure of power, equipment or systems not provided by the Company. Credit for failure of the Service shall be allowed only when such failure is caused by or occurs due to causes within the control of the Company.

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- 2.6.4 Credit shall not be issued for unavailability of long distance services.
- 2.6.5 The Company will not refund or issue credit for unused Telecom Units on any Prepaid Calling Card.

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2.7 **Deposit**

The Company does not require deposits.

2.8 **Taxes**

All federal, state and local taxes, excluding sales tax, assessed on the sale and use of the Customer's Prepaid Calling Card are paid by the Company out of the purchase price of the Prepaid Calling Card.

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2.9 **Location of Service**

The Company will provide service to Customers within the State of Florida.

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3. <u>SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE</u>

3.1 Computation of Charges and Timing

3.1.1 All calls must be charged against a Prepaid Calling Card. The total charge for each completed call is dependent upon the duration of the call. The charge is not dependent upon distance. Calls made with a Prepaid Phone Card are rounded up to the next full minute. If a partial minute is used, then the card will be charged for a full minute. There will be a surcharge for calls made from payphones as set forth in Section 4 of this tariff. Customers may call either of the Company's customer service numbers for additional rate information:

- 3.1.2 A Telecom Unit is deducted from Prepaid Calling Cards only when the called party answers and two way communication is possible, as determined by standard industry methods generally in use for ascertaining answer, including hardware answer supervision in which the local telephone company sends a signal to the switch or software utilizing audio tone detection. Timing for each call ends when either party hangs up. When the balance is depleted, the customer can dispose of the Prepaid Calling Card and purchase a new Prepaid Calling Card.
- 3.1.3 The Company will not deduct Telecom Units for uncompleted calls.

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3.4 Service Offerings

3.4.1 Prepaid Calling Cards

This Service permits the use of Prepaid Calling Cards for placing calls between points within the State of Florida.

Customers may purchase Prepaid Calling Cards at a variety of retail outlets or through other distribution channels. Prepaid Calling Cards are available at a variety of face values. Prepaid Calling Cards must be used from a touch-tone phone. Service is accessed using the toll-free number or local access number printed on the card. The caller is prompted by an automated voice response system to enter his/her Authorization Code, and then to enter the terminating telephone number. The Company's processor tracks the call duration on a real time basis to determine the number of Telecom Units consumed. The total consumed Telecom Units and applicable taxes and fees for each call are deducted from the remaining Telecom Unit balance on the Customer's Prepaid Calling Card.

All calls must be charged against a Prepaid Calling Card that has a sufficient Telecom Unit balance. A Customer's call will be interrupted with an announcement when the balance is about to be depleted. When the balance is depleted, the Customer can dispose of the Prepaid Calling Card and purchase a new Prepaid Calling Card. Calls in progress will be terminated by the Company if the balance on the Prepaid Calling Card is insufficient to continue the call.

Prepaid Calling Cards are not refundable. A card will expire on the date indicated on the card or, if no date is specified, 90 days from the date of first usage, whichever is later. The Company will not refund unused balances.

Prepaid Calling Cards may be used only from the state specified or nationwide, whichever is stated on the card or accompanying information.
