### MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(4), F.A.C., Miami-Dade County (the "County"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests the confidential classification of the entire document bates stamped MDC\_PSC(4) 00001 (the "Confidential Document"), which delineates its current list of customers, and was requested for production by the Florida Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff") and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") in this matter. In support of its request for confidential classification, the County states:

- 1. The Confidential Document constitutes a trade secret. § 812.081, Fla. Stat. (2005). "[T]rade secret information as defined in s. 812.081, and as provided for in s. 815.04(3), [is] expressly made confidential and exempt from the public records law ...." § 815.045, Fla. Stat. (2005). The Confidential Document qualifies for protection as proprietary confidential business information pursuant to § 364.183(3)(a), Florida Statutes.
- 2. The Confidential Document is (i) confidential and exempt, (ii) intended to be and is treated by the County as private, and (iii) has not been disclosed.


