Thank you for your assistance with Docket 060619-TX. As we discussed on 10/24, I was literally handed the agenda letter from the Commission on the 24th. I had not seen any of the referenced correspondence nor data requests that the Commission had previously sent, and still have not to this point. The position at North American Telecom that would have handled such requests has experienced extensive turnover over the last several months.

Regardless, I am now the individual who will be handling all such requests going forward and I respectfully request the Commission consider accepting our settlement offer of \$3,500, payable in \$500 monthly installments if approved. We are an extremely small CLEC with fewer than 3,000 total local lines and less than 3 dozen T1 circuits in service, so our data would have had an incredibly small impact on the Commission's reports.
