

JOINT PETITION FOR WAIVER

Pursuant to Rule 25-24.455(4), Trinsic Communications, Inc. ("Trinsic" or "Seller") and Communications Xchange, LLC. ("Communications Xchange" or "Buyer") (together, "Petitioners") respectfully request that the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") waive Florida Administrative Code rule 25-24.118, in order to facilitate the transfer of customers from Trinsic to Communications Xchange, LLC., both certificated telecommunications carriers in the state of Florida.

Upon approval of this waiver request, Trinsic seeks to transfer approximately 207 presubscribed customers in Florida to Communications Xchange. On or about November 1, 2006, the parties sent a notification to all affected customers. This notification advised the customers of the following: the pending change of their carrier selection to Communications Xchange; that there will be no change to the rates, terms, and conditions of the service(s) to be provided by the acquiring carrier; that there will be no charge to the customer in connection with this change; that the subscriber has the right to select a different preferred carrier; toll-free customer service telephone numbers for inquiries about the transfer; the fact that all subscribers receiving the notice, including those who have arranged preferred carrier freezes through their local service providers, will be transferred to the new carrier if they do not select a different preferred carrier before the transfer date; and whether the acquiring carrier will be responsible for resolving outstanding complaints against the selling or transferring carrier. A sample copy of the customer notification is attached to this Petition as Exhibit A.

Petitioners respectfully request that the Commission issue an order granting a wavier of Rule 25-24.118 in order to consummate the transfer of customers. In support of this request, Petitioners provide the following information:

I. THE PETITIONERS and PARTIES

Trinsic Communications, Inc. ("Trinsic") is a local exchange and non-dominant interexchange telecommunications service provider incorporated under the laws of the State of Delaware. Trinsic was granted authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Florida by Order No. PSC-98-1177-FOF-TX issued September 22, 1998 in DN 980786-TX under the name Z-Tel Communications, Inc. Interexchange authority was granted pursuant to Order No. PSC-98-1235-FOF-TI issued September 21, 1998 in DN 980665-TI. The company's name was changed to Trinsic Communications, Inc. in February 2005, pursuant to order issued in DN 041457. Trinsic is certified, registered or otherwise authorized to provide local and long distance services nationwide. Trinsic seeks to transfer approximately the aforementioned presubscribed customers of its services in Florida to Communications Xchange. Following the transaction, Trinsic will continue to provide service to its remaining customers in Florida.

Communications Xchange, LLC. ("Communications Xchange"), a Florida corporation, was granted local exchange authority in Docket No. 020682 in October 2002 and interexchange authority in Docket No. 020681 in November 2002. Communications Xchange's managerial, technical and financial ability to provide telecommunications services are a matter of record with the Florida Public Service Commission. A copy of the company's Certificate to Transact Business as a Foreign Corporation is incorporated herein by reference.

III. REQUEST FOR RULE WAIVER

Pursuant to Rule 25-24.118(1), Florida Administrative Code, the provider of a customer shall not be changed without the customer's authorization. Rule 25-24.118-(2) provides that a local provider or IXC shall submit a change request to the local exchange carrier only if one of the following has occurred: (a) the provider has a letter of agency from the customer requesting the change; (b) the provider has received a customer-initiated call for service; or (c) a third party firm has verified the customer's requested change. As a result of the proposed transfer agreement described above, the Petitioners ask the Commission to waive the conditions in 25-24.118-(2) in order to allow the transfer of customers of record to Communications Xchange. A Notice has been filed with the Federal Communications Commission for a waiver of the authorization and verification rules for implementation of the subscriber carrier selection change provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

IV. CUSTOMER IMPACT

This transaction will be made in a seamless fashion that will avoid disruption to consumers. Existing customers of the Petitioners will not be inconvenienced in any way. There will be no interruption of service and customers will be well informed of their choices.


V. PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS

The Petitioners have determined that the proposed transaction will improve operational efficiency of both companies, thus providing greater opportunities to improve the price performance of services available to its customers. If prior authorization is required in this event, customers may fail to respond to a request for authorization, neglect to select another long distance carrier and lose their long distance service during the transition. Consequently, granting this Petition is consistent with the public interest in promoting competition among telecommunications carriers in Florida. Further, by granting this Petition, unnecessary slamming complaints will be prevented during the transition, saving Petitioners and the Commission administrative burdens.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the Petitioners submit that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Joint Petition for Waiver of Rule 25-24.118.
