Pursuant to Order No. PSC-06-0843-FOF-WS, issued October 9, 2006, Certificate Nos. 602-W and 518-S are to be administratively cancelled upon verification of the transfer dates and payment of regulatory assessment fees (RAFS) up through the date of the transfers. Transfer of the water systems on October 4, 2006, to the City of Apopka and Zellwood Station Community Association, Inc. was verified by affidavits filed in Document Number 09371-06, on October 10, 2006. In addition, the Commission has received 2006 water RAFs for Zellwood Station Co-Op. Inc. up through the date of transfer and staff has verified that the amount is reasonable.

Therefore, staff requests that Certificate No. 602-W, held by Zellwood Station Co-Op, Inc., be cancelled effective October 4, 2006. The docket should remain open pending confirmation of the transfer of the wastewater system.
